This funding proposal was then rejected by the Department of Energy because they classified the project as “research and development” (R&D). This project is not R&D but is a production facility that produces renewable energy from biogas and organic liquid fertilizer. The R&D was completed before moving forward with construction of 20,000 square feet of facilities. The Cherokee Hills RC&D Council, OCC, ODAFF, OACD and others are trying to get DOE to reconsider. Congressman Boren and others have been engaged to intercede on this project that provides a viable alternative for poultry litter disposal. This in turn continues to provide better nutrient management options in watersheds that provide drinking water for rural communities and Tulsa. This funding would have created over 35 rural jobs.

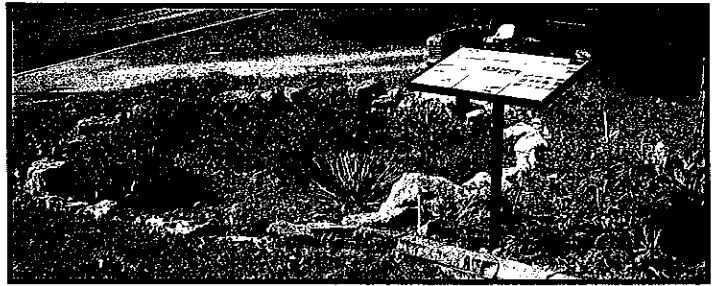
