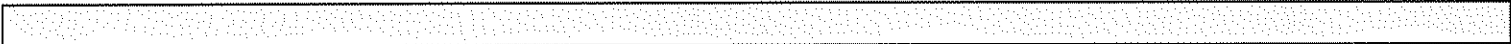

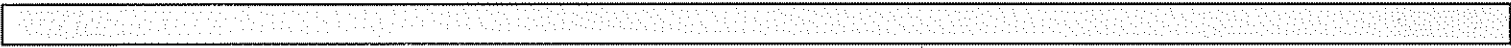

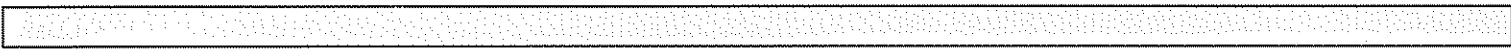

The contractor, United General Contractors, Inc. has completed 94 percent of the reclamation work. The remaining item of work is fencing, which will be done when the site conditions are favorable.
2. Greer Phase 1 - 208 (Rogers County)
The contractor, United General Contractors, Inc., completed 97 percent of the reclamation work while using 83 percent of the contract time.
3. Sokolosky - 222 (Tulsa County)
The prebid meeting for contractors will be held March or April.
4. 61st Street North NE - 167 (Wagoner County)
The bids were opened February 1. On February 2 the OCC accepted Thomas Construction Inc., of Ft. Scott, Kansas, as the low bidder at \$752,469.25. Construction is expected to start in early March.

AML EMERGENCY PROGRAM

Ute Street (Pittsburg County) -

On January 24 a Declaration of Emergency was made for a site in Hartshorne. A dangerous vertical sinkhole with active erosion suddenly collapsed in Ute Street. The sinkhole was located in the north traffic lane. At the surface the hole was 2 feet in diameter. Under the surface crust it was 6 feet long by 4 feet wide by 5½ feet deep. Active erosion was taking dirt deeper underground. A high probability of danger existed to vehicles using the street as well as to humans and pets in the area.


