The Oklahoma Conservation Commission met Monday, March 4, 2019, at the Agriculture Building Conference Room located at 2800 N. Lincoln in Oklahoma City, Oklahoma. The meeting was called to order at 9:30 a.m. by Chair Bill Clark. He stated this was a regular scheduled meeting held in accordance with the Open Meeting Law, Title 25, Oklahoma Statutes, Sections 301 and following as amended. MINUTES OF PREVIOUS REGULAR MEETING

A motion was made by Mr. Herriman and seconded by Mr. Jett to approve the minutes of the February 11, 2019, Commission meeting as written. Those voting aye were: Jett, Clark, Campbell and Herriman. Nay votes: none. Motion carried.

CLAIMS/FINANCIAL STATEMENT

Nancy Tackett, Oklahoma Department of Agriculture Comptroller, presented the claims, purchase card summary and financial statement as listed in Exhibit #1. A motion was made by Mr. Campbell and seconded by Mr. Jett to approve the claims and financial statement. Those voting aye were: Jett, Clark, Campbell, and Herriman. Nay votes: none. Motion carried.

PRESENTATION OF COMMISSION AGREEMENTS

Mrs. Owen led a discussion about the possible approval of the following amended agreement (Exhibit #2):

Natural Resources Conservation Service (OCC-574) to provide assistance to NRCS and conservation districts through a shared staffing agreement for two clerical staff to carry out tasks to assist in the delivery of Farm Bill programs as well as administrative tasks for the conservation district. Amendment 1 adds two shared clerical staff in Pushmataha and Bryan Conservation Districts. Mrs. Owen would recommend the approval of the amendment as presented. A motion to approve was made by Mr. Herriman and seconded by Mr. Campbell. Those voting aye were: Jett, Clark, Campbell, and Herriman. Nay votes: none. Motion carried.

OUT OF STATE TRAVEL REQUEST

Mr. Lam presented an out of state travel request for possible approval as listed in Exhibit #3. A motion was made by Mr. Jett and seconded by Mr. Campbell to approve the travel request as presented. Those voting aye were: Jett, Clark, Campbell, and Herriman. Nay votes: none. Motion carried.

DISCUSSION AND POSSIBLE APPROVAL OF RECOMMENDATION FOR APPOINTMENT OF CONSERVATION DISTRICT DIRECTORS

Mrs. Owen presented the recommendation for appointment of conservation district directors as listed in Exhibit #4. She would recommend that these individuals be confirmed. Mr. Jett made a motion to approve and it was seconded by Mr. Campbell. Those voting aye were: Jett, Clark, Campbell, and Herriman. Nay votes: none. Motion carried.

DISCUSSION AND POSSIBLE APPROVAL TO CO-SPONSOR EVENTS

Trey Lam presented information regarding the upcoming Conservation Day at the Capitol on April 23 and National Land and Range Judging Contest on April 30 - May 1-2. He indicated that sponsorship would involve staff time for hosting the events. A motion was made by Mr. Herriman and seconded by Mr. Jett to approve the co-sponsorships of both events. Those voting aye were: Jett, Clark, Campbell, and Herriman. Nay votes: none. Motion carried.

VIEWING OF GRAND RIVER DAM ANUTHORITY'S VIDEO PRESENTATION: Our Borrowed Waters

Following the viewing of the video presentation; Commissioner's thanked Ed Fite, VP of Water, Scenic Rivers and Water Quality for Grand River Dam Authority, for his partnership with the agency and commitment to improving water quality along the Illinois River. No action required.

PUBLIC COMMENTS

NEW BUSINESS

The Declaration of Emergency, dated March 4, 2019, for the Haileyville School 6 Abandoned Mine Land (AML) Emergency was ratified by the Commissioners with a unanimous vote. Under the provisions of the Oklahoma Public Competitive Bidding Act (Title 61 – Section 130), Trey Lam, as chief administrative officer for the Oklahoma Conservation Commission, has the authority to declare an emergency with such action and the reasons thereof to be recorded in the official minutes of the Oklahoma Conservation Commission. The Haileyville School 6 AML Emergency involved the sudden collapse of an abandoned coal mine creating a vertical opening 10 feet in diameter and 7 feet deep. The site is in the Haileyville School yard/playground with a high probability of substantial harm to the students, school personnel and visiting public. The site is located at 200 Riley Avenue, Haileyville, Pittsburg County, Oklahoma. A motion was made for ratification by Mr. Campbell and seconded by Mr. Herriman. Those voting aye were: Jett, Campbell, Herriman, and Clark. Nay votes: none. Motion carried.

CONSERVATION PARTNERSHIP REPORTS

Oklahoma Department of Agriculture, Food and Forestry: Jan Lee Rowlett, , Oklahoma Department of Agriculture Legislative Liaison, reported on the following items:

-She is excited to begin working for the Oklahoma Department of Agriculture and looks forward to meeting everyone.

Natural Resources Conservation Service: Gary O'Neill, State Conservationist, reported on the following items:

- He is pleased that the last version of the Farm Bill from 2014 remained largely intact with the passage of the new Farm Bill. There were no programs that were lost in the passage.
- NRCS is currently awaiting the definite rules for the programs to implement the new Farm Bill.
- NRCS may begin to keep their field offices open on Saturdays in order to better serve the communities they reside in.
- -There are ongoing efforts to walk tribal conservation districts through operations and development practices.
- -Mr. O'Neil stated that he will be attending the Washington D.C. fly-in to visit with legislators and meet with leaders at NRCS's headquarters.

Oklahoma Association of Conservation Districts: Larry Wright, President, reported on the following items:

- -There was 69 conservation districts in attendance at this year's OACD State Meeting.
- -Bill Jordan and Larry Wright will attend the Washington D.C. fly-in.
- -OACD is looking to partner with the Chickasaw Nation on various conservation programs.
- -OACD is interested in partnering with *Pollinators in the Rough*, which is a program aimed at installing plant material for pollinators on several golf courses around the state of Oklahoma.

OKLAHOMA CONSERVATION COMMISSION MEMBERS

Mr. Campbell reported that he thoroughly enjoyed the OACD State Meeting this year and had several good interactions with our legislators that were in attendance.

Mr. Jett reported that he believes that it is important to have senators and representatives involved in all of our conservation events. He states that those like Jim Grego are interested in being a strong partner to conservation in Oklahoma.

Mr. Herriman stated that he attended the OACD State Meeting and really enjoyed the new Soil Health speakers this year.

Mrs. LeGrand was not in attendance.

Mr. Clark stated he also attend the OACD State Meeting. He noted that it is fun to listen to people that are passionate about what they do.

OKLAHOMA CONSERVATION COMMISSION STAFF

Executive Director: Mr. Lam stated a written report is in the packet. Mr. Lam reported on the following items:

- Attend the OACD State Meeting in Oklahoma City.
- Wanted to extend a warm welcome to incoming OACD President, Larry Wright.
- Met with the Cherokee Nation with Gary O'Neill to discuss conservation efforts.
- Met with the bonding authority. They propose to roll the new bond in with the current bond. This will result in a savings of approximately four-hundred thousand dollars (\$400,000.00) with an improvement to the interest rate.

Water Quality Program: Shanon Phillips, Director stated a written report was in the packet. Ms. Phillips reported on the following items:

- Stated that she learned a lot from the Water Quality Conference in Wyoming that she and Greg Kloxin attended. She noted that some of the highlights were: Regular communication with all staff is essential in fostering an efficient work environment. She also stated that it is important for Water Quality folks to remind conservation districts ways in which they can serve them.

Office of Geographic Information and Technical Services: Mike Sharp, Director, stated a written report is in the packet. He noted that GIS Day at the Capitol is tomorrow and encouraged those with no prior commitments to attend.

Abandoned Mine Land Reclamation Program: Robert Toole, Abandoned Mine Lands Reclamation Program Director, stated that a written report was in the Commissioner's packet. Mr. Toole summarized the report stating that: Construction was initiated on one project; Construction is on-going on two projects; four projects are pending environmental clearances; Vegetation & maintenance management is being performed on four projects; four projects are in the design phase; two sites are in realty phase, and; four sites are pending project selection.

Conservation Programs: Tammy Sawatzky, Director stated that a written report was in the packet. Ms. Sawatzky reported on the following items:

- Ms. Sawatzky and Janet Stewart (OCC General Counsel) attended a town-hall meeting in Perry, Oklahoma to discuss the rehabilitation of Perry Lake (Upper Black Bear Site 62). The meeting had lots of engagement from the public.

Assistant Director: Mrs. Owen noted that monthly activities are outlined in the written report. Mrs. Owen reported on the following items:

- The Agreement between Oklahoma State University and the Oklahoma Conservation Commission has been amended.
- Mrs. Owen, along with her staff, have been busy assisting OACD in the preparations for the State Meeting.



STATE GUIDELINES FOR THE CONSERVATION COST-SHARE PROGRAM

PROGRAM YEAR 20

Program Year Begins: April 1, 2019 Program Year Ends: September 30, 2020

Allocation Period Begins: April 1, 2019 Allocation Period Ends: September 30, 2019

Oklahoma Conservation Commission in cooperation with Oklahoma's 84 Conservation Districts

I GENERAL

The Oklahoma Conservation Commission hereby declares that the following problems are having a detrimental effect on the renewable natural resources of our state:

Oklahoma's water and soil resources are an important foundation of the state's economic infrastructure. Natural climatic events as well as human activity are impacting these two natural resources. As long as farmers and ranchers produce food from the land to feed the world and the wind blows and the rain falls, we will continue to see impacts on soil and water. Our task as stewards of these natural resources is to minimize these impacts. Protecting these vital natural resources is paramount in preserving the state's economic future. In order to accomplish this goal, the Conservation Commission hereby establishes the following goals and objectives to address these problems affecting our renewable natural resources:

Make cost-share funds available to conservation districts so that they can implement cost-share practices which will protect our soil and water natural resources.

The Conservation Commission herein establishes the complete list and description of the conservation Cost-Share Program policies and conservation practices approved for use by the conservation districts during Program Year 20. See Section II for the approved list of conservation practices with their respective range of cost-share rates for each of the Conservation Cost-Share Program initiatives. State cost-share average costs (unit cost) are based on Oklahoma Natural Resources Conservation Service (NRCS) data.

Any exceptions from these established Conservation Cost-Share Program policies and guidelines shall be approved by the Conservation Commission.

II ALLOCATION OF FUNDS

A. <u>Locally Led Conservation Initiative</u>

The Conservation Commission allocates \$1,365,000 of FY 2019 appropriations to the Conservation Cost-Share Fund for the purposes of providing cost-share payments to eligible participants for implementing approved cost-share conservation practices.

B. Conservation District Allocation

The amount of funds allocated to each conservation district from the FY 2019 appropriation for Program Year 20 appears on page 12. These funds will be available to conservation districts on April 1, 2019.

Conservation districts that have unobligated Program Year 19 funds may submit a request to the Conservation Commission to carry those funds over for use in

Program Year 20. Requests will include the district's final Program Year 19 Monthly Report. The amount of each district's carry over funds will be based on their performance ranking during Program Years 16, 17, and 18.

III POLICIES

A. Allocation Period

The allocation period shall start April 1, 2019 and end September 30, 2020. Any funds allocated to districts and not obligated during the allocation period for Program Year 20 will be released by the district and made available for reallocation by the Conservation Commission. Funds become obligated to a participant after approval of the application by the board and a performance agreement has been signed and dated by the district board and the participant.

B. <u>Authorized/Designated Representatives</u>

The district board must designate an authorized district representative. This person can sign all forms. The authorized district representative must be a district board member. It cannot be a district employee.

The district must designate a technical representative. The designated technical representative will assist in developing conservation plans and determining the need for conservation practices. The representative will also be responsible for design and layout of approved conservation practices, determining compliance with approved standards and specifications, and certifying conservation practice quantities and completion of conservation practices.

C. Conservation Practices

Each district board may select any of the approved cost-share conservation practices within the Locally Led Conservation Initiative for inclusion in the district's local guidelines. The selection should be based on which practices will best address the district's highest priority problems affecting renewable natural resources.

Cost-share practices shall be implemented according to NRCS standards and specifications. In the event NRCS standards and specifications do not exist, conservation practices must meet Conservation Commission approved standards and specifications.

D. Average Costs

State average cost (unit cost) for these practices is based on Oklahoma NRCS data. In order for a variance to be considered the request must be in writing and accompanied by supporting data compiled by the district. The variance rate must be approved by the Conservation Commission prior to the board's approval of Program applications and performance agreements being signed.

E. <u>Cost-Share Payments</u>

The minimum cost-share payment amount that shall be made to any participant from these funds is \$100. The maximum cost-share payment amount that shall be made to any participant from these funds is \$5,000.

F. Cost-Share Rate

The maximum cost-share rate for these practices is 75%. District boards may choose to set cost-share rate less than the specified rate.

G. Eligibility

Applicants for the Conservation Cost-Share Program must be a district cooperator with a conservation plan.

Conservation Commissioners, Conservation Commission staff, conservation district employees or the spouses of any of these people shall not be eligible to participate in the Conservation Cost-Share Program.

Conservation district directors are eligible to participate in the Conservation Cost-Share Program. Due to the limited amount of funds available for Program Year 20 individual directors should give careful consideration to public perception when making their decision to participate in the Program. If the local board votes to allow board members to apply for Program Year 20 the guidelines below will be followed.

- Individual district board members applying cannot discuss any element of the Cost-Share Program including but not limited to practices, rates, average costs, selection criteria, application approval/disapprovals, cost-share payments, and extensions.
- 2. Individual district board members applying for the Cost-Share Program must abstain from voting on all elements of the Program.
- 3. Individual district board members cannot use their position as a conservation district board member to improve or elevate their individual chances of becoming a successful applicant.

H. Agreements

All Program Year 20 performance agreements must be signed and dated by the district board and participant on or before September 30, 2019. All Program Year 20 performance agreements must be completed and the check in the hand of the participant on or before September 30, 2020. Installation of conservation practices cannot begin until an effective performance agreement is in place. A performance agreement becomes effective on the last date of signature. Each participant should have only one performance agreement.

Each participant is required to sign a maintenance agreement. Completion of the maintenance agreement and signature of the participant are required prior to the disbursement of the cost-share payment.

IV APPROVED CONSERVATION PRACTICES

Contained in this section is a list of all conservation practice's approved for use in the Program Year 20 Locally Led Conservation Initiative. The conservation district shall only use conservation practices listed here unless a special request is approved by the Conservation Commission. In order for a conservation practice special request to be considered the request must be in writing and accompanied by supporting documentation. The special request must be approved by the Conservation Commission prior to the board's approval of Program applications and performance agreements being signed.

State average cost (unit cost) for these practices is based on Oklahoma NRCS data. In order for a variance to be considered the request must be in writing and accompanied by supporting data compiled by the district. The variance rate must be approved by the Conservation Commission prior to performance agreements being signed.

Below are the conservation practices approved for Program Year 20.

314 - Brush Management

Definition: The management or removal of woody (non-herbaceous or succulent) plants including those that are invasive and noxious.

Purpose:

- Create the desired plant community consistent with the ecological site or a desired state within the site description.
- Restore or release desired vegetative cover to protect soils, control erosion, reduce sediment, improve water quality or enhance hydrology.
- Maintain, modify or enhance fish and wildlife habitat.
- Improve forage accessibility, quality and quantity for livestock and wildlife.
- Manage fuel loads to achieve desired conditions.
- Pervasive plan species are controlled to a desired level of treatment that will ultimately contribute to creation or maintenance of an ecological site description "steady state" addressing the need for forage, wildlife habitat, and/or water quality.

315 – Herbaceous Weed Control

Definition: Removal or control of herbaceous weeds including invasive, noxious and prohibited plants.

Purpose:

- Enhance accessibility, quantity, and quality of forage and/or browse.
- Restore or release native or create desired plant communities and wildlife habitats consistent with the site potential.
- Protect soils and control erosion.
- Reduce fine fuel loads and wildlife hazard.
- Pervasive plan species are controlled to a desired level of treatment that will ultimately contribute to creation or maintenance of an ecological site description "steady state" addressing the need for forage, wildlife habitat, and/or water quality.
- Improve rangeland health.

338 – Prescribed Burning

Definition: Controlled fire applied to a predetermined area.

Purpose:

- Control undesirable vegetation.
- Prepare sites for harvesting, planting or seeding.
- Control plant disease.
- Reduce wildfire hazards.
- Improve wildlife habitat.
- Improve plant production quantity and/or quality.
- Remove slash and debris.
- Enhance seed and seedling production.
- Facilitate distribution of grazing and browsing animals.
- Restore and maintain ecological sites.

340 - Cover Crop

Definition: Grasses, legumes, and forbs planted for seasonal vegetative cover.

Purpose:

- Reduce erosion from wind and water.
- Maintain or increase soil health and organic matter content.
- Reduce water quality degradation by utilizing excessive soil nutrients.
- Suppress excessive weed pressures and break pest cycles.
- Improve soil moisture use efficiency.
- Minimize soil compaction.

342 - Critical Area Planting

Definition: Establishing permanent vegetation on sites that have, or are expected to have, high erosion rates, and on sites that have physical, chemical or biological conditions that prevent the establishment of vegetation with normal seeding/planting methods.

Purpose:

- Stabilize stream and channel banks, pond and other shorelines, earthen features of structural conservation practices.
- Stabilize areas with existing or expected high rates of soil erosion by wind or water.
- Stabilize areas, such as sand dunes and riparian areas.

362 – Diversion (new structures only)

Definition: A channel generally constructed across the slope with a supporting ridge on the lower side.

Purpose:

- Break up concentrations of water on long slopes, on undulating land surfaces and on land that is generally considered too flat or irregular for terracing.
- Divert water away from farmsteads, agricultural waste systems, and other improvements.
- Collect or direct water for storage, water-spreading, or waterharvesting systems.
- Protect terrace systems by diverting water from the top terrace where topography, land use, or land ownership prevents terracing the land
- Intercept surface and shallow subsurface flow.

- Reduce runoff damages from upland runoff.
- Reduce erosion and runoff on urban or developing areas and at construction or mining sites.
- Divert water away from active gullies or critically eroding areas.
- Supplement water management on conservation cropping or stripcropping systems.

378 - Pond (new structures only)

Definition: A water impoundment made by constructing an embankment, by

excavating a dugout, or by a combination of both.

Purpose: A pond stores water for livestock, fish and wildlife, recreation, fire control,

erosion control, flow detention, and other uses such as improving water

quality.

382 - Fencing

Definition: A constructed barrier to animals or people. (Does not include temporary

fence.)

Purpose: This practice facilitates the accomplishment of conservation objectives by

providing a means to control movement of animals and people, including

vehicles.

NOTE: This practice is to be used only in conjunction with the Pond (378) or as cross fencing for grazing management.

394 – Firebreak

Definition: A permanent or temporary strip of bare or vegetated land planned to

retard fire.

Purpose: • Reduce the spread of wildfire.

• Contain prescribed burns.

410 - Grade Stabilization Structure

Definition: A structure used to control the grade in natural or constructed channels.

Purpose: To stabilize the grade, reduce erosion or improve water quality.

412 - Grassed Waterway (new structures only)

Definition: A shaped or graded channel that is established with suitable vegetation to

convey surface water at a non-erosive velocity using a broad and shallow

cross section to a stable outlet.

Purpose: • To convey runoff from terraces, diversions, or other water concentrations without causing erosion or flooding.

To reduce gully erosion.

• To protect/improve water quality.

512 - Forage and Biomass Planting

Definition: Establishing adapted and /or compatible species, varieties, or cultivars of

herbaceous species suitable for pasture, hay, or biomass production.

- Improve or maintain livestock nutrition and/or health.
- Provide or increase forage supply during periods of low forage production.
- Improve soil and water quality.
- Produce feedstock for biofuel or energy production.

516 - Pipeline

Definition: Pipeline and appurtenances installed to convey water for livestock or

wildlife.

Purpose: • Convey water to points of use for livestock or wildlife.

• Reduce energy use.

• Develop renewable energy systems.

533 - Pumping Plant

Definition: A facility that delivers water at a designed pressure and flow rate. Includes

the required pump(s), associated power unit(s), plumbing, appurtenances, and may include on-site fuel or energy source(s), and protective

structures.

• Delivery of water for irrigation, watering facilities, wetlands, or fire Purpose: protection.

- Removal of excessive subsurface or surface water.
- Provide efficient use of water on irrigated land.
- Improvement of air quality.
- Reduce energy use.

550 - Range Planting

Definition: Establishing of adapted perennial or self-sustaining vegetation such as

grasses, forbs, legumes, shrubs and trees.

• Restore a plant community similar to the ecological site description Purpose: reference state for the site or the desired plant community.

- Provide or improve forages for livestock.
- Provide or improve forage, browse or cover for wildlife.
- Reduce erosion by wind and/or water.
- Improve water quality and quantity.
- Increase carbon sequestration.

561 – Heavy Use Area Protection

Definition: To stabilize a ground surface that is frequently and intensively used by people, animals, or vehicles.

• To provide a stable, non-eroding surface for areas frequently used by Purpose: animals, people or vehicles.

• To protect and improve water quality.

600 - Terrace

Definition: An earth embankment, or a combination ridge and channel, constructed across the field slope.

614 - Watering Facility

Definition: A means of providing drinking water to livestock or wildlife.

Definition: A hole drilled, dug, driven, bored, jetted or otherwise constructed into an

aguifer for water supply.
