AML EMERGENCY PROGRAM

Highway 270-Haileyville #2 (Pittsburg County)

This project addresses an emergency situation involving the sudden collapse of an abandoned underground coal mine, creating a sinkhole in the ditch of U.S. Highway 270 in Haileyville, Oklahoma. The dangerous vertical sinkhole is 4.5 feet in diameter by 10.5 feet deep, and is 29 feet from the highway asphalt. It is open to the surface and has active erosion taking dirt deeper underground. A person or animal falling into this sinkhole would fall 10.5 feet creating a high probability of harm. The vertical walls would prevent escape.

NATIONAL ASSOCIATION OF ABANDONED MINE LAND PROGRAMS (NAAML P)

The AML Program hosted the 2009 NAAML P Winter Meeting at the Courtyard by Marriott in Oklahoma City, March 17-18. The meeting was attended by state and tribal AML Program managers, Office of Surface Mining staff, and representatives of the Bureau of Land Management, National Forest Service, National Park Service, and the Interstate Mining Compact Commission.

The topics of discussion at the meeting included AML funding, AMLIS, AML Final Rules for the 2006 Amendments to SMCRA, ARRA Economic Stimulus Funding Support, the Emergency Program status, SMCRA Amendment Training, and Directive Changes to FAM and AML-1, and the opportunities for partnerships between state/tribal AML programs and the Bureau of Land Management, National Forest Service, and National Park Service on projects using Stimulus funding. The Association passed a Stay Out and Stay Alive resolution urging extreme caution to those exploring abandoned mines and historic mining areas. The program managers agreed to write letters to U.S. Senators and U.S. Representatives concerning the President's FY 2010 budget and the serious impacts it would have on AML states and tribes.
