The Oklahoma Conservation Commission met Monday, April 1, 2019, in the Agriculture Building Conference Room located at 2800 N. Lincoln in Oklahoma City, Oklahoma. The meeting was called to order at 9:30 a.m. by Chair Bill Clark. He stated this was a regular scheduled meeting held in accordance with the Open Meeting Law, Title 25, Oklahoma Statutes, Sections 301 and following as amended. #### MINUTES OF PREVIOUS REGULAR MEETING

A motion was made by Mr. Herriman and seconded by Mr. Jett to approve the minutes of the March 4, 2019 Commission meeting as written. Those voting aye were: Jett, Clark, Campbell, Herriman, and LeGrand. Nay votes: none. Motion carried.

### **CLAIMS/FINANCIAL STATEMENT**

Nancy Tackett, Comptroller, presented the claims, purchase card summary and financial statement as listed in Exhibit #1. A motion was made by Mr. Campbell and seconded by Mrs. LeGrand to approve the claims and financial statement. Those voting aye were: Jett, Clark, Campbell, Herriman, and LeGrand. Nay votes: none. Motion carried.

### RECOGNITION OF COMMISSION EMPLOYEE

Karla Spinner, WQ Environmental Program Specialist, presented Candice Miller, WQ Division Blue Thumb Educator and Project WET Coordinator with an award for Employee of the Quarter at the Oklahoma Conservation Commission. She stated that Ms. Miller was nominated by Cheryl Cheadle for this award and read a brief statement submitted on her behalf.

### PRESENTATION OF AGREEMENTS

Mrs. Owen presented three agreements listed as item "A-C" in Exhibit 2, for possible approval.

The first agreement (Item A) is a ratification of an amendment that will change the agreement between the Oklahoma Conservation Commission and Natural Resources Conservation Service from a 75% to a 50% federally funded salary for the Communications Director. Mrs. Owen recommends ratification of this amendment as presented. A motion was made by Mr. Campbell and seconded by Mr. Jett to ratify the amendment. Those voting aye were: Jett, Clark, Campbell, Herriman, and LeGrand. Nay votes: none. Motion carried.

The second agreement (Item B) is an amendment of an existing agreement between Oklahoma State University and Grand River Dam Authority. The amendment will extend the date of the agreement to December 31, 2021 and add additional funds to support development of restoration planning in the Saline Creek sub-watershed of Hudson Lake. Mrs. Owen recommends approval of the amended agreement as presented. A motion was made by Mr. Herriman and seconded by Ms. LeGrand to approve the amendment. Those voting aye were: Jett, Clark, Campbell, Herriman, and LeGrand. Nay votes: none. Motion carried.

The third agreement (Item C) is a new agreement with the Oklahoma Office of Secretary of Energy and Environment to convey funding from the EPA 2019/2020 grant to provide staff support and funding toward implementation of Oklahoma's Comprehensive Nonpoint Source Management Program throughout assessment, planning, education and implementation. Mrs. Owen recommends approval of the new agreement as presented. A motion was made by Mr. Jett and seconded by Ms. LeGrand to approve the new agreement. Those voting aye were: Jett, Clark, Campbell, Herriman, and LeGrand. Nay votes: none. Motion carried.

### DISCUSSION AND POSSIBLE APPROVAL OF THE STATE COST SHARE PROGRAM GUIDELINES

Mrs. Sawatzky, Conservation Programs Director, presented to the board the newly updated guidelines for the Oklahoma Cost Share Program. She stated that this is the 20<sup>th</sup> year for the cost share program and that there have been some changes made in the system in which funds are allocated to conservation districts. She also noted that this year, the conservation districts will be eligible to participate in a new soil health initiative that partners with NRCS. The new soil health initiative has a separate funding amount of two-hundred and thirty-five thousand dollars (\$235,000.00) and additional information and guidelines will be presented later in the year. The overall cost share program is one-million three-hundred and sixty-five thousand dollars (\$1,365,000.00) for this fiscal year. A motion was made by Mrs. LeGrand and seconded by Mr. Campbell to approve the cost share guidelines as presented. Those voting aye were: Jett, Clark, Campbell, Herriman, and LeGrand. Nay votes: none. Motion carried.

### **CONSERVATION PARTNERSHIP REPORTS**

Oklahoma Department of Agriculture, Food and Forestry: No report from ODAFF staff. Natural Resources Conservation Service: Gary O'Neill, State Conservationist, reported on the following items:

- -Will host a tribal listening session on the implementation of the Farm Bill. The first session will be hosted in Shawnee and the second will be hosted in Miami, Oklahoma.
- -Chief Lore will attend the National Land Range Judging Contest in May, 2019.
- -NRCS is anxious to get the Feral Hog Eradication pilot program off the ground and expects it to commence in June, 2019. There will be more details provided at a later time.
- -Dana Davis, of NRCS, will participate in the OCC's employee training seminar. She will

be speaking about how to make the NRCS/OCC partnership work within conservation districts.

Oklahoma Association of Conservation Districts: Larry Wright, OACD President gave the following update:

- -Bill Jordan and himself attended the Washington D.C. Fly-In and had really good success in speaking with key legislative members.
  - -The Southcentral Regional Meeting will be held in July, 2019 in Thackerville, Oklahoma.
  - -OACD wrapped up their leadership class in Elk City.
  - -The Kaleo Foundation donated a truck-load of seed that are to be disbursed to conservation districts at the employee's training seminar in Oklahoma City.

### OKLAHOMA CONSERVATION COMMISSION MEMBERS

Mr. Jett stated that he had nothing new to report.

Mr. Campbell stated that he also attended the Washington D.C. Spring Fly-In and appreciated the opportunity to be so involved in conservation. He also commented on the visibility of the Oklahoma Conservation Commission's partnership with the Natural Resource Conservation Service.

Mr. Herriman stated that he had nothing new to report.

Mrs. LeGrand briefly discussed the rainfall in her Area.

Mr. Clark stated he attended the Washington D.C. Spring Fly-In as well and was pleased with the amount of Oklahomans in attendance. He stated that they were fortunate enough to get to visit with Senator James Lankford, of Oklahoma.

### OKLAHOMA CONSERVATION COMMISSION STAFF

*Executive Director*: Mr. Lam stated a written report is in the packet. Mr. Lam reported on the following items:

- The Gross Production tax looks like it will head to Governor Stitt's desk to be signed next month.
- He participated in a poultry meeting with the Gary O'Neil and the Cherokee Nation.
- Visited Rock Creek 15 with Tammy Sawatzky for the final inspection after rehabilitation has been completed.
- Will participate in Conservation Day at the Capitol on April 23, 2019.
- Would like to extend a warm well to Bryan Painter, the agency's new Communications Director.

Water Quality Program: Mrs. Phillips reported on the following items:

- -The 2018 Annual Report on Non-Point Source Pollution has been approved by the Environmental Protection Agency.
- -Mrs. Phillips would like to extend a warm welcome to Shelby Burridge, the newest member of the Water Quality Division's staff. Ms. Burridge will be filling Judith Wilkin's role as well as assisting with planning and water quality monitoring initiatives.

Office of Geographic Information and Technical Services: Mike Sharp, Director, stated a written report is in the packet. He noted that GIS Day at the capitol went very well and that there was a lot of participation this year. Mr. Sharp stated that Governor Stitt and his Information

Communications Secretary both attended the event.

Abandoned Mine Land Reclamation Program: Robert Toole, Abandoned Mine Lands Reclamation Program Director, introduced Kendall Brookins as the newest member of the OCC-AML Team. Kendall will serve as AML Administrative Assistant under the supervision of Dianne Ireton. Mr. Toole noted that a written report was in the Commissioner's packet. He summarized the report stating that: construction was now completed on the Haileyville 6 AML Emergency and distributed pictures of the completed project. He concluded saying that construction, monitoring, maintenance, vegetation, designs, realty, inventorying and assessments were progressing as noted in the written report.

*Conservation Programs:* Tammy Sawatzky, Director stated that a written report was in the packet. Mrs. Sawatzky reported the following items:

- Clancy Green represented the Agency for a one mile run to kick off the Governor's announcement to encourage participation in the Memorial Marathon.
- Janet Stewart has spent many hours this month working on pipeline issues with upstream flood control structures.

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

Reasons for Emergency Declaration:

This project addresses a situation involving the sudden collapse of an abandon coal mine creating an vertical opening. Erosion is taking dirt deeper underground. The current approximate dimensions are 2 feet diameter by 8 feet deep with a side opening extending an additional 7 feet.

This site is located in a densely populated residential area of Tulsa, Oklahoma, in the backyard of a family home. There is a high probability of substantial harm to the children, other family, utility workers, and visitors.

The vertical opening is located at 5424 East 17th Street in Tulsa, Oklahoma. The Legal description is NE SW of Section 10, Township 19 North, Range 13 East in Tulsa County (Tulsa USGS Quadrangle), Oklahoma. The geographic coordinates are: 36.13811, -95.91477.
