MINUTES

CALL TO ORDER

The Oklahoma Conservation Commission met Wednesday, May 2, 2018, at the Agriculture Building Conference Room located at 2800 N. Lincoln in Oklahoma City, Oklahoma. The meeting was called to order at 9:30 a.m. by Chairman Deanna LeGrand. She stated this was a rescheduled Regular Meeting held in accordance with the Open Meeting Law, Title 25, Oklahoma Statutes, Sections 301 and following as amended. The agenda for this meeting was posted at 4:20 p.m. Monday, April 30, 2018, at the front entrance of the building. It was noted by Commissioner Herriman that a clerical error on the posted agenda stated Monday, May 2. After consultation with Janet Stewart, General Counsel, the meeting continued as the date and time were posted correctly on-line and there were no inquiries received by the Commission from Monday, April 30 to the start of the meeting Wednesday regarding the day of the week for the meeting.

DISTRICT DIRECTOR ELECTIONS FOR POSITION #2

Ms. Owen discussed with Commissioners the process for conducting conservation district elections. After discussion, a motion was made by Mr. Herriman and seconded by Mr. Campbell to authorize Executive Director Lam to certify eligibility of candidates filing a Notification and Declaration of Candidacy for District Director Election and approve polling places in conservation districts where two or more candidates filed a Notification and Declaration of Candidacy for Election. Those voting aye were: Jett, Campbell, Herriman and LeGrand. Nay votes: none. Motion carried.

PROPOSED EXECUTIVE SESSION

At 9:54 a.m., a motion was made by Mr. Herriman and seconded by Mr. Campbell to enter Executive Session as authorized by the Oklahoma Meeting Act Section 307 (B)(1) of Title 25 of the Oklahoma Statutes to discuss the Executive Director's salary. Those voting aye were: Jett, Campbell, Herriman and LeGrand. Nay votes: none. Motion carried. The Commissioners requested that Ms. Owen remain in Executive Session to take minutes.

At 10:22 a.m., the Commission re-entered open session. A motion was made by Mr. Jett and seconded by Mr. Campbell to return to open session. Those voting aye were: Jett, Campbell, Herriman and LeGrand. Nay votes: none. Motion carried.

Ms. LeGrand, Chair, stated that the Commission would take no action at this time but directed staff to prepare the Fiscal Year 2019 budget for consideration to include an increase to the Executive Director's salary based on pay grade recommendations from the Office of Management and Enterprise Services Human Capital Management.

NEW BUSINESS

None.

CONSERVATION PARTNERSHIP REPORTS

Oklahoma Department of Agriculture, Food and Forestry: Jeremy Seiger, Agricultural Environmental Management Services Director reported on the following items:

-As of January 1, 2018 there have been 922 individual wildfires burning 680,000 acres. Of these, 144 were considered large or significant fires that have burned 455,610 acres. The Department has received fire control assistance from 32 states.

-The Governor has signed the Fiscal Year 2019 budget. Other legislation that passed included a bill signed that would provide limited liability protection to recreational land. Legislation also passed that eliminates the eastern red cedar board and in its place creates an eastern red cedar directory.

-The Department was unable to come to consensus with Department of Public Safety (DPS) on the proposed amendment to the bill related to Electronic Logging Devices. However, DPS indicated it will honor the Agriculture Exemption.

- The Feral Hog Night Hunting bill is being debated on the floor today.

-The Legislature plans to adjourn on May 4, 2018.

- The Agriculture Hall of Fame presentations will be made May 9.

-Oklahoma State University announced a Health Sciences scholarship for FFA and 4-H students.

USDA-Natural Resources Conservation Service: Gary O'Neill, State Conservationist reported on the following items:

- Hosted a very positive and successful tour with USDA Undersecretary, Bill Northey and Chief Administrative Officer, Clovis Adams. The Undersecretary indicated that he had no desire to see NRCS merged with FSA in programmatic areas. He also stated that he hoped to have the hiring limitations figured out by July.

- NRCS announced a special sign up period for fire victims in western Oklahoma.
- 23 student interns start late May and early June.
- Working with OCC to requests for flood control rehabilitation funding.
- NRCS watershed operations reported \$150 million available funding for remedial repairs, backlog projects and new construction.

- Met with OCC to discuss the conservation planning for the state cost-share program.

Oklahoma Association of Conservation Districts: Jimmy Emmons, President reported on the following items:

- An honor to meet Undersecretary Northey.
- Was so thankful for the firefighters in Dewey County. The fires in Dewey County burned 389,000 acres including 70 homes. This represents 2% of the county population. SBA funding has been requested for fire disaster.

- Hunter O'Daniel, son of Deer Creek Conservation District Director will receive an award for his work on the Farm to Food Bank during the state FFA convention.

- Garden gleanings will start in late May or early June.

- All five directors of the Dewey County Conservation District were affected by the wildfires. The district is offering hay wagons and drills to landowners needing assistance due to the wildfires. Thanks to Cindy Bierig, Major County Conservation District, Chris Allen, South Caddo Conservation District and Keith Owen, National Association of Conservation Districts for assisting the district following the wildfires.

- National Land and Range Judging Contest began yesterday with the contest being held tomorrow.

OKLAHOMA CONSERVATION COMMISSION MEMBERS

Mr. Campbell reported that the Conservation Awards ceremony was a huge success. He stated that Emmons Farms being recognized as the first Leopold Conservation Award recipient is putting Oklahoma on the map in a good way.

Mr. Jett reported that he had attended the Woodward County Bankers Award Banquet. He also noted that he is working with Clay Pope to organize a prescribed fire management workshop in Goodwell, OK.

Mr. Herriman stated he had nothing to report this month.

Ms. LeGrand reported that she has assisted with fire relief in her area and that there were two Upper Washita Conservation District Directors directly affected by wildfire.

OKLAHOMA CONSERVATION COMMISSION STAFF

Executive Director: Mr. Lam stated a complete written report is in the packet. Mr. Lam reported on the following items:

- The Governor signed the Fiscal Year 19 budget which shows a .71% increase for the Conservation Commission. Included this year are a \$5.116 million bond issue for watershed rehabilitation and a pay raise for state and district employees.
- Participated in the Conservation Awards ceremony and spoke on behalf of the Commission in the presentation of the first annual Leopold Award.
- Attended the Craig County Farm Show and Expo
- Toured fire damaged areas of Dewey County
- Attended the Woodward County Bankers Award program
- Participated in a tour of Oklahoma with Congressman Frank Lucas and USDA Undersecretary Bill Northey. Conservation District Directors met with tour at each stop of the tour. Mr. Lam thanked staff for their excellent presentations during the tour.
- Attended the Wildfire Relief Meeting in Woodward.
- Attended Feral Hog Outreach Meeting hosted by Dewey and Major County Conservation Districts.

Water Quality Program: Shanon Phillips, Director stated a written report was in the packet.

- She reported that the education staff has been very busy this past month with 19 separate events in 20 days.
- Staff continues to work on Oklahoma Water Resources Board State Revolving Fund projects with Grand River Dam Authority to develop bio retention cells.
- She and Greg Kloxin, Water Quality Assistant Director, attended an Illinois River Modeling meeting where EPA and Oklahoma and Arkansas State Agencies discussed potential steps following the release of the models by EPA in April. Oklahoma agencies will work during the summer of 2018 to formulate a more definitive plan for next steps in the watershed.

Office of Geographic Information and Technical Services: Mike Sharp, Director, stated a written report is in the packet. He noted that this was a fairly routine month for the division.

Abandoned Mine Land Reclamation Program: Robert Toole, Director, stated that a written report was in the Commissioner's packet. In the interest of time, he stated he would yield to questions.

Conservation Programs: Tammy Sawatzky, Director, stated a written report is in the packet. Ms. Sawatzky reported on the following items:

- Over a period of two days a team of six watershed technicians and aides inspected dams in Logan County Conservation District.
- Prepared and submitted bid package for rehabilitation of Cottonwood Site 54. Scheduled a mandatory pre-bid meeting for May 22.
- Working with Love County Conservation District on construction of a new watershed site on Lower Bayou.

Assistant Director: Ms. Owen noted that monthly activities are outlined in the written report. Ms. Owen reported on the following items:

- Attended the Payne County Conservation District Awards Banquet
 - Assisted Logan County Conservation District with board meeting and day-to-day operations. Advertised to fill vacant District Manager position.
 - Attended the confirmation hearing for Scotty Herriman.
- Met with OMES to discuss the Conservation District Liability policy renewal; mailed out risk management survey to districts; compiled data for submission of bid quote for the policy.
- Gathered paperwork from districts for elections and appointments.
 - Prepared fiscal impact data for Senate Fiscal staff for conservation district employee raises.
