The Oklahoma Conservation Commission met Monday, June 6, 2016, at the Agriculture Building Board Room located at 2800 N. Lincoln in Oklahoma City, Oklahoma. The meeting was called to order at 9:30 a.m. by Chairman Mike Rooker. He stated this was a Regular Meeting scheduled in accordance with the Open Meeting Law, Title 25, Oklahoma Statutes, Sections 301 and following as amended. ## **MINUTES OF PREVIOUS REGULAR MEETING**

A motion was made by Ms. LeGrand and seconded by Mr. Clark to approve the minutes of the May 2, 2016 Commission meeting as written. Those voting aye were: Jett, Rooker, Herriman, LeGrand and Clark. Nay votes: none. Motion carried.

## **CLAIMS/FINANCIAL STATEMENT**

Steve Coffman, Financial Management and Human Resources Director, presented the claims and financial statement as listed in Exhibit #1. Mr. Jett questioned why there were no claims listed for Blaine County or Beaver County Conservation Districts. Mr. Coffman will check. Members also questioned the bond payment and what the bond money was used for. It was stated that the money was used for repairs on conservation practices, Sugar Creek Watershed, trucks, skid steers, trailers, and watershed rehabilitation. After discussion, a motion was made by Mr. Jett and seconded by Mr. Herriman to approve the claims and financial statement. Those voting aye were: Jett, Rooker, Herriman, LeGrand and Clark. A motion was made by Mr. Clark and seconded by Mr. Jett to ratify approval of the new agreement as listed. Those voting aye were: Jett, Rooker, Herriman, LeGrand and Clark. Nay votes: none. Motion carried.

Ms. Owen recommended approval of the new agreement listed as (l). A motion was made by Ms. LeGrand and seconded by Mr. Herriman to ratify approval of the new agreement as listed. Those voting aye were: Jett, Rooker, Herriman, LeGrand and Clark. Nay votes: none. Motion carried.

Ms. Owen recommended approval of amended agreements listed as (m) and (n). A motion was made by Mr. Jett and seconded by Ms. LeGrand to approve the amended agreement as listed. Those voting aye were: Jett, Rooker, Herriman, LeGrand and Clark. Nay votes: none. Motion carried.

## **OUT OF STATE TRAVEL REQUESTS**

Trey Lam, Executive Director, presented travel requests for approval as listed in Exhibit #3. A motion was made by Mr. Herriman and seconded by Mr. Clark to approve the requests as listed. Those voting aye were: Jett, Rooker, Herriman, LeGrand and Clark. Nay votes: none. Motion carried.

## **NACD SOUTH CENTRAL MEETING**

Mr. Lam stated that the National Association of Conservation Districts South Central Region Meeting will be held August 9-11, 2016 in Little Rock, Arkansas. Although we do not have cost information for the meeting he would like to get an idea of which commission members are interested in attending. Mr. Herriman stated that the days of all members attending meetings are over. Mr. Lam stated that the Commission still needs to have a presence at these meetings. Mr. Rooker and Mr. Jett expressed interest in attending. Staff will provide cost information as soon as it is available and we will take action at the July meeting for attendance.

## **RECOMMENDATIONS FOR APPOINTMENT**

Kim Tweed, Executive Secretary, presented the recommendations for appointment of conservation district directors as listed in Exhibit #4. A motion was made by Ms. LeGrand and seconded by Mr. Clark to approve district director appointments as listed. Those voting aye were: Jett, Rooker, Herriman, LeGrand and Clark. Nay votes: none. Motion carried.

## **DECLARE CANDIDATES ELECTED**

Ms. Tweed stated that Exhibit #5 lists districts where only one eligible person filed a *Notification and Declaration of Candidacy* and recommended that the Commission declare the candidate listed as elected to Position #3. A motion was made by Mr. Jett and seconded by Mr. Herriman to declare the candidates as elected. Those voting aye were: Jett, Rooker, Herriman, LeGrand and Clark. Nay votes: none. Motion carried.

## **AUTHORIZE EXECUTIVE TO DECLARE CANDIDATES ELECTED**

Ms. Tweed stated that since the district director elections are held on Tuesday, June 7, the Commission will need to authorize the executive director to declare candidates receiving the highest number of votes during the Cherokee County Conservation District election and the Texas County Conservation District election for District Director Position #3 as elected to said position (Exhibit #6). A motion was made by Mr. Herriman and seconded by Mr. Clark to approve the authorization as listed. Those voting aye were: Jett, Rooker, Herriman, LeGrand and Clark. Nay votes: none. Motion carried.

## **COMMISSION'S FY2017 APPROPRIATION AND BUDGET**

Mr. Lam stated that the Commission received \$9,039,000 for FY2017 which is down 2.39 percent. However, from where we started last year we have received a 16.2 percent cut amounting to \$1.3 million. Budget meetings with each division are being scheduled to prepare a budget to present to the Commission in July. Mr. Lam stated that there would be no furloughs for Commission or district employees but positions will be left open.

Mr. Lam stated that the Conservation Infrastructure Revolving Fund was reauthorized but that fund is down over \$1 million. The Commission uses these funds for cost-share and priority watersheds.

## CONSERVATION PARTNERSHIP REPORTS

*Oklahoma Department of Agriculture, Food and Forestry:* Jeremy Seiger, Agricultural Environmental Management Services Director, introduced Betty Thompson as the new Deputy Commissioner. He then provided copies of the Ag Stats Handbook as well as Diseases of Feral Swine. Mr. Seiger stated that AMES is revising the poultry territory responsibilities. He reported on a tour held for Ron Carleton, the agriculture liaison to the EPA Administrator. He thanked Commission staff for assisting with the tour of Pennington Creek.

Mr. Seiger stated that the Department and the Commission are working to generate a report for the general public of the work done in the Illinois River Watershed. He stated that Department staff will be meeting with Ed Fite, director of the former Oklahoma Scenic Rivers Commission, and setting up interviews with producers and other agency staff.

Mr. Seiger stated that the Governor vetoed the bill regarding feral hog but that an executive order was signed to allow hunting day or night without a permit; during deer season a permit would be needed.

*USDA-Natural Resources Conservation Service:* Gary O'Neill, State Conservationist, stated that changes to the Conservation Stewardship Program will be rolled out October 1 for next year's signup. This program will be administered like the Environmental Quality Incentive Program (EQIP) with up to 170 potential enhancements. Mr. O'Neill stated that Oklahoma received an additional \$2 million for EQIP which brought the total for Oklahoma to \$22 million.

Mr. O'Neill advised that a civil rights review is scheduled and those will take place in the following field offices: Oklahoma State Office, Newkirk, Nowata, Claremore, Shawnee, Seminole, Wilburton, Poteau, Chandler, Kingfisher, Enid, Alva, Clinton, Hobart, Duncan, and Chickasha. The reviews will consist of interviews with a landowner and a district board member.

Mr. O'Neill stated that Brian Dillard, Watershed Office Project Engineer, has accepted a job with the Corps of Engineers and that Rick Lane is Acting. Andy Bennet, District Conservationist (DC) in Frederick has been named the new CSP Manager; Ryan Jones, DC in Cordell, has been named Resource Specialist for that part of the state and Matt Ward has been named Resource Conservationist for the northeast area. Kenny Hitch has been detailed to a national team for CSP.

*Oklahoma Association of Conservation Districts:* Kim Farber, Past President, stated that the National Land and Range Judging Contest was a success with over 100 teams consisting of 500 students from 34 states. She stated that Larry Wright will be taking a more active role in the contest. She thanked Mr. Lam and the Commission staff for their work as well as the NRCS.

Ms. Farber reported on demonstration farm projects stated that Area 3 is in Ottawa County (Grant Victor) and Area 4 is in Kiowa County (Matt Braun). Jordan Shearer is coordinating these projects with the NRCS.

On July 23 a field day will be held at Goldsby and lunch will be provided and participants should RSVP to Sara Blaney. Jimmy Emmons, Dewey County, will host a field day on July 28 and participants should RSVP to Dewey County.

The Area 3 meeting is scheduled on November 3 at the Fairgrounds in Vinita and Area 5 meeting is October 25 in Wilburton. The NACD South Central Meeting will be held at the Wyndam Riverfront Hotel in Little Rock.

Dewey County Conservation District celebrated its 75<sup>th</sup> anniversary and Rogers County CD will celebrate its on July 24.

### **OKLAHOMA CONSERVATION COMMISSION MEMBERS**

Mr. Jett was confirmed by the State Senate for another five year term. He stated that Beaver County Conservation District has partnered with the County Extension and the Oklahoma Food Bank and recently fed 35 people in the area. He reported on attending the Harper County cover crop field day and stated two more were scheduled in July.

Mr. Clark attended a meeting with the Noble Foundation, OSU, NRCS and OCC to discuss getting more conservation on the ground and working together as a team.

Ms. LeGrand attended the Dewey County CD 75<sup>th</sup> anniversary celebration.

Mr. Herriman reported on his cover crops.

Mr. Rooker attended the National Land and Range Judging Contest.

### **OKLAHOMA CONSERVATION COMMISSION STAFF**

*Executive Director:* Mr. Lam stated a written report is in the packet. He attended the Senate confirmation hearing form Mr. Jett and is glad to have him on the Commission for another five years. Mr. Lam thanked the Department of Agriculture for including the Commission in the tour for Mr. Carleton.

Mr. Lam attended the National Land and Range Judging Contest and stated it as a success. He also attended the meeting at the Noble Foundation to discuss conservation business. He stated that because of that meeting there may be opportunity to partner with OSU on shared district positions and with the NRCS on employees working half time with NRCS and half time with districts.

*Water Quality Program:* Greg Kloxin, Assistant Director, stated a written report is in the packet. He stated that staff is in the fourth cycle of its ambient monitoring program noting that one cycle takes five years. Mr. Kloxin stated that staff is working on the National Wetlands Assessment.

Staff met with RCPP leaders in Elk City and northeast Oklahoma to discuss new proposals. Mr. Kloxin also expressed his appreciation to the Department of Agriculture for including the Commission in the tour for Mr. Carleton.

Stacy Hansen, Carbon Program Director, reported on Cowboy Plant ID training recently held in Sulphur and Hugo. There are twelve more planned with the next two in Cheyenne and Freedom.

Mr. Kloxin stated that the division made a staff adjustment and took one water quality monitoring specialist, Blane Stacy, to work with Greg Scott on the soil health initiative.

*Office of Geographic Information and Technical Services:* Mike Sharp, Director, stated a written report is in the packet. He reported that the USGS will do LIDAR for all of Oklahoma east of Slapout.

*Abandoned Mine Land Reclamation Program:* Robert Toole, Director, stated a written report is in the packet. He reported that two projects are in construction, two are undergoing repairs, three are in the vegetative phase due to rains, two are in design phase; 13 are in the survey phase, and three are having American Burying Beetle (ABB) surveys. Mr. Toole reported that a proposal has been made to take the ABB off the endangered species list which would be a long process.

Mr. Toole introduced Acacia Croy as the new Environmental Specialist.

*Conservation Programs:* Tammy Sawatzky, Director, stated a written report is in the packet. She stated that due to December flooding that four watershed sites have been approved for repair under the Emergency Watershed Program in Atoka County, Hughes County, Latimer County and Sequoyah County Conservation Districts. Current EWP projects have been delayed due to rain.

*Assistant Director:* Ms. Owen stated a written report is in the packet. She gave a presentation at the Dewey County CD 75<sup>th</sup> anniversary celebration. She stated that when the district began 25 people signed a petition and over 700 people voted to establish the district.

Ms. Owen also attended the meeting with the Noble Foundation and stated she is in discussions with the OSU extension for shared services to districts. She has been named to the board of directors of the Oklahoma Prescribed Burn Association replacing Darrel Dominick. Ms. Owen had an exhibit at the Master Gardener's Conference where over 300 people were in attendance.

Ms. Owen thanked the Department of Agriculture's Investigative Services Division who assisted the Commission and the Lincoln County Conservation District with theft of several pieces of equipment. They recovered a trailer, skid steer, mower and gator.

She stated that the Financial Management and Human Resources staff will be getting budget meeting scheduled and closing out purchase orders.

#### **OFFICERS FOR FY2017**

A motion was made by Mr. Jett and seconded by Ms. LeGrand to approve officers for Fiscal Year 2017 as follows: Scotty Herriman, Chair; Deanna LeGrand, Vice Chair; and Bill Clark, Secretary. Those voting aye were: Jett, Rooker, Herriman, LeGrand and Clark. Nay votes: none. Motion carried.

Ms. Farber stated that the next OACD Executive Board Meeting is August 16 at 1:00 p.m. at the Downtown Embassy Suites and she invited members to attend. The state meeting will be held at this hotel next year.

Mr. Rooker invited members to attend his wheat binding demonstration on June 11 and the Farm Feed Show on June 17 and 18.

#### **NEXT MEETING**

The next regular meeting of the Oklahoma Conservation Commission will be held on Monday, July 11, 2016, in the Agriculture Building Board Room, 2800 N. Lincoln Boulevard, Oklahoma City, Oklahoma beginning at 9:30 a.m.

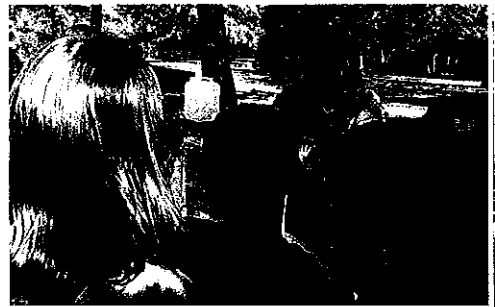
