1. McPheeters - 258 (Rogers County)

All work is complete.

2. Greer Phase 1 - 208 (Rogers County)

All work is complete.

3. Sokolosky - 222 (Tulsa County)

All work is complete. Vegetation coverage is less than 70 percent; therefore, the project remains open.

4. 61st Street North NE - 167 (Wagoner County)

The contractor, Thomas Construction Inc., has completed 98 percent of the reclamation work while using 96 percent of the contract time.

FY 2007 AML SIMPLIFIED GRANT (\$1,610,000) The following is a status report on the project in this grant:

1. 61st Street North SW - 167 (Wagoner County)

The contractor, Thomas Construction Inc., has completed 7 percent of the reclamation work while using 15 percent of the contract time.

FY 2008 AML SIMPLIFIED GRANT (\$1,955,266) On May 22 the AML Program staff submitted the second reclamation project for this grant to the Office of Surface Mining. The project is the Greer Phase 2 - 248 AML Project, located in Rogers County. On June 17 the AML Program staff submitted the third reclamation project for this grant to the Office of Surface Mining. The project is the LCUM 5 AML Project, located in LeFlore County. The Office of Surface Mining now must sign the authorizations to proceed. The following is a status report on the projects in this grant:

1. West Chelsea Phase 2 - 248 (Rogers County)

Seven contractors attended the prebid meeting held at the site on June 3. The bids were opened on June 12. The apparent low bidder is Wilson Ranch and Excavating LLC, of Sperry, Oklahoma, at \$464,359.32. The AML staff is checking references and equipment before approving the company as low bidder.

2. Greer Phase 2 - 208 (Rogers County)

The Office of Surface Mining must sign the authorization to proceed before the project can be submitted to the Department of Central Services to begin the contracting process.

3. LCUM 5 (LeFlore County)

These Priority 2 sites are named the LCUM 5 (LeFlore County Underground Mines # 5) Project. It is the fifth such project in LeFlore County. It is primarily located in the northern part of the county in a high growth area with many new homes being built. It consists of numerous dangerous, abandoned underground coal mine problems including 15 Portals (P), 15 Vertical Air Shafts (VAS), 29 Subsidences (Sub), 4 Vertical Openings (VO), 1 Hazardous Equipment Facility (HEF), and adjacent surface damage associated with each site's mining operations. Some sites are open and others have potential for voids underneath. These sites present a high probability of danger to the landowners, children, cowboys, pasture workers and their equipment, hunters, livestock, wildlife, explorers, 4-wheelers, and others visiting the area. The potential for a serious accident, bodily injury, or entrapment is quite high. Due to the increasing population of the area, continuing residential development, and the potential for an accident, these sites need to be abated as soon as possible.

The Oklahoma Conservation Commission proposes to use federal funds from the Office of Surface Mining to abate these public safety hazards at each site. The following abatement/reclamation actions are being proposed:

All sites will be excavated, then stabilized by plugging/packing with rocks and clay or other earthen materials from commercial borrow pits and/or on-site and off-site previously disturbed areas.

The previous and current disturbed areas will be graded, shaped, and smoothed to conform to each site's adjacent topography for permanent safety and use.

All disturbed areas will be fertilized and seeded with perennial ryegrass and Bermudagrass to establish a permanent vegetative cover.

Approximately 8.6 acres of land will be reclaimed. The estimated cost range of the project is between \$210,000 and \$280,000.

The Office of Surface Mining must sign the authorization to proceed before the project can be submitted to the Department of Central Services to begin the contracting process.
