Highway 270-Haileyville #2 (Pittsburg County)

Project was completed on May 21,2009, at a construction cost of \$6,134.40.

Hartshorne School #2 (Pittsburg County)

The site was declared an emergency by the Oklahoma Conservation Commission on May 27, 2009. This project addresses an emergency situation involving the sudden collapse of an abandoned underground coal mine creating a sinkhole in the parking lot of the Hartshorne High School in Hartshorne, Oklahoma. The dangerous vertical sinkhole is 4 feet in diameter by 2.5 feet deep, and is 101 feet from a school building. It is open to the surface and has active erosion taking dirt deeper underground.
