PUBLIC INFORMATION CAMPAIGN

Purpose:

Increased public awareness of services and assistance from NRCS, the Commission and conservation districts. The agreement will provide funding for the production of pamphlets, feature articles, news releases, Op/Ed pieces, PowerPoint presentations and displays for use in promoting conservation in the state.

Goal:

Accelerated delivery of public information will result in enhanced soil, water and related natural resources conservation. This agreement will provide a formal cooperative effort between the NRCS and the OCC to combine their efforts to successfully implement a more effective outreach and public information initiative to a diverse constituency. The combined resources will result in enhancement, conservation, restoration, and protection of land and water resources in the State of Oklahoma.

Products:

(Original, October 2004)

1. **Feature Stories** - A minimum of 12 feature articles for major newspapers, local/county news media, magazines and regionally important print media.

These articles will highlight:

- Oklahoma conservation partnership efforts;
- Specific conservation programs will be (ex. EQIP; WHIP; WRP; CTA; state Cost Share and others)
- A diverse customer base
- Local conservation districts, directors and employees, and local NRCS staff
- On-site interviews and photographs.

2. **Opinion/Editorial Pieces (Op/Ed)**- Approximately 12 op/ed pieces of approximately 300 – 400 words each, written by state conservation partnership leaders and provided to publications for printing. These will focus on the importance of conservation efforts, partnerships, programs, and locally led conservation.

3. **Outreach to Groups and Associations** - Develop outreach information and do active outreach activities to other groups and associations to make them aware of conservation services. These include animal industry associations, production agriculture, wildlife and environmental entities. (OACD)

4. **PowerPoint Presentation** - A PowerPoint presentation explaining the identities, roles and responsibilities of the members of the conservation partnership. The presentation will be developed so that each of the partners could use the whole or part of the presentation to explain the partner's role and technical/financial assistance available.

5. **Public Service Announcements (PSA)** – Four radio public service announcements for local radio stations across the state regarding general information about services and technical and financial assistance, and highlighting where to get additional information. These will also highlight home page addresses. Spanish and Laotian versions will be made for specific outreach in certain markets.

6. **Outreach Advertisements** - Outreach Advertisements developed and targeted to specific audiences and locations, as needed, placed across the state or in target locations.

August 2007

7. **Pamphlets/Brochures** – At least four printed pieces, pamphlets, brochures, etc., in color with information and photographs, distributed to districts and field offices.
8. **Statewide News Releases** – Monthly news releases about ongoing conservation topics for statewide distribution by the Oklahoma Press Service.
9. **Local News Releases** – Fill-in the blank type news releases on conservation topics distributed to districts for them to add local information and provide to local news media.
10. **Newsletter Column** – A space in OCC's newsletter, the *Oklahoma Conservation Conversation*, reserved for a recurring column by NRCS on a topic that agency's choice.
