CALL TO ORDER

The Oklahoma Conservation Commission met Monday, September 9, 2019, at the Agriculture Building Conference Room located at 2800 N. Lincoln in Oklahoma City, Oklahoma. The meeting was called to order at 9:30 a.m. by Vice Chair, Commissioner Phil Campbell. He stated this was a regular scheduled meeting held in accordance with the Open Meeting Law, Title 25, Oklahoma Statutes, Sections 301 and following as amended. The agenda for this meeting was posted at 1:00 p.m. Thursday, September 5, 2019, at the front entrance of the building.

PLEDGE OF ALLEGIANCE

MINUTES OF PREVIOUS REGULAR MEETING

A motion was made by Mr. Clark and seconded by Mr. Herriman to approve the minutes of the August 1, 2019, Commission meeting as written. Those voting aye were: Clark, Campbell, Herriman and Forst. Nay votes: none. Motion carried.

CLAIMS/FINANCIAL STATEMENT

Lisa Knauf Owen, presented the claims, purchase card summary and financial statement as listed in Exhibit #1. A motion was made by Mr. Forst and seconded by Mr. Clark to approve the claims and financial statement. Those voting aye were: Clark, Campbell, Herriman and Forst. Nay votes: none. Motion carried.

PRESENTATION OF AGREEMENTS

Those voting aye were: Clark, Campbell, Herriman and Forst. Nay votes: none. Motion carried.

Mrs. Owen presented five new agreements listed as "d-h" in Exhibit 2 for consideration. She recommended approval of the new agreements as presented. A motion was made by Mr. Herriman and seconded by Mr. Clark to approve the new agreements. Those voting aye were: Clark, Campbell, Herriman and Forst. Nay votes: none. Motion carried.

OUT OF STATE TRAVEL REQUEST

Mr. Lam presented an out of state travel request listed as item "a" in Exhibit 3 for possible ratification that was previously approved by Chair Jett. A motion was made by Mr. Herriman and seconded by Mr. Clark to ratify the travel request as presented. Those voting aye were: Clark, Campbell, Herriman and Forst. Nay votes: none. Motion carried.

Mr. Lam presented two new out of state travel requests listed as items "b-c" in Exhibit 3 for possible approval. A motion was made by Mr. Clark and seconded by Mr. Forst to approve the out of state travel request as presented. Those voting aye were: Clark, Campbell, Herriman and Forst. Nay votes: none. DISCUSSION & APPROVAL OF CONSERVATION DISTRICT DIRECTORS

Mrs. Owen led a brief discussion about the possible approval of conservation district directors as presented in Exhibit #4. She recommends that the board approve them as presented. A motion was made by Mr. Clark and seconded by Mr. Forst to approve the directors. Those voting aye were: Clark, Campbell, Herriman and Forst. Nay votes: none. Motion carried.

DISCUSSION & POSSIBLE APPROVAL OF LONG RANGE PLANS

Mrs. Owen led a discussion about the long range plans that were received for approval by the Commission. She noted that Ellis County Conservation District is the only remaining Long

Range Plan to be completed. Mrs. Owen recommended approval of the Long Range Plans as presented in Exhibit #5. A motion was made by Mr. Forst and seconded by Mr. Clark to approve the Long Range Plans as presented. Those voting aye were: Clark, Campbell, Herriman and Forst. Nay votes: none. Motion carried.

DISCUSSION & POSSIBLE APPROVAL OF JOINT PLANS OF OPERATIONS

Mrs. Owen stated that eighty joint plans of operation have been completed to date. She noted that Okfuskee and Osage County Conservation Districts were making corrections to their plans and will be presented for approval next month. She also stated that Ellis County Conservation District's plan remains the final one to be completed. She would recommend the approval of the Joint Plans of Operation as presented in Exhibit #6. A motion was made by Mr. Clark and seconded by Mr. Herriman to approve the Joint Plans of Operations as presented in Exhibit #6. Those voting aye were: Clark, Campbell, Herriman and Forst. Nay votes: none. Motion carried.

DISCUSSION & POSSIBLE APPROVAL TO CO-SPONSOR THE OACD AREA MEETINGS

Mr. Lam led a discussion about some of this year's area meeting highlights. He noted that Susan Paddock, Executive Director of the OKA' Institute will be providing training for district directors. Mr. Lam would recommend approval to co-sponsor the area meetings along with the Oklahoma Association of Conservation Districts. A motion was made by Mr. Herriman and seconded by Mr. Clark to approve the co-sponsorship of the meetings. Those voting aye were: Clark, Campbell, Herriman and Forst. Nay votes: none. Motion carried.

2019 EPA – 319 NON-POINT SOURCE SUCCESS STORIES

Shanon Phillips, Water Quality Division Director, presented information to the Commissioners on this year's EPA 319 Non-Point Source Success Stories. Mrs. Phillips reported that this year, in partnership with NRCS, conservation districts, landowners, EPA, OCC and others, Oklahoma recognized 12 new streams as Nonpoint Source Success Stories. This brings the total of Oklahoma streams fully or partially delisted from the 303(d) list to 84, more than any other state in the Nation. In addition, Oklahoma added three updates to previous success stories by delisting additional pollutants. This brings the total pollutant delisting for Oklahoma to 120, which is also more than any other state.

She further stated that these de-listings recognize reductions in bacteria, turbidity, and salts and improvements in dissolved oxygen and pH in streams across the state. This year we are excited to recognize 5 segments in the Illinois River basin for reduced E.coli bacteria concentrations. This suggests that we are moving in the right direction in the basin; although much work remains to address nutrient concerns and maintain the progress that we've made, the conservation installed in voluntary programs has made an impact. These 84 stories are the result of the partnership between landowners and land managers, conservation districts, NRCS, and others to protect natural resources. Capturing the success of those efforts is possible due to the investment in long-term water quality monitoring made by OCC and other partners.

CONSERVATION PARTNERSHIP REPORTS

Oklahoma Department of Agriculture, Food and Forestry: Kenny Naylor, Department of Agriculture, Food and Forestry, reported on the following items:

- In regards to hemp production permits, there have been more than twenty-one thousand four-hundred (21,400) acres that have been designated for production.
- Hemp producers are beginning to harvest their first crops.
- There have been eighty-five (85) pesticide complaints in southwestern Oklahoma in July, 2019.

Natural Resources Conservation Service: Gary O'Neill, State Conservationist, reported on the following items:

- RCPP grant proposals deadline is in ninety (90) days.
- Flood plain easement sign-up ends September 30, 2019.
- CSP grasslands obligations have been busy this year.
- Associate Chief, Kevin Norton spoke at the NRCS meeting in Norman. He stated that NRCS intends to focus on streamlining their programs to improve efficiency across the agency.
- NRCS has recently developed an Outcome Divisions.

Oklahoma Association of Conservation Districts: Larry Wright, President, reported on the following items:

- Participating on the National Association of Conservation Districts Urban & Community Resource Policy Committee
- OACD is busy setting up grants that will be made available to conservation districts.
- OACD would like to express gratitude to OCC for agreeing to co-sponsor the area meetings in November. More information pertaining to the Area Meetings will be available soon.
- OACD plans to focus some efforts in reengaging students at Southwestern Oklahoma State University.

OKLAHOMA CONSERVATION COMMISSION MEMBERS

Mr. Campbell reported that he is planning an outreach meeting on September 24, 2019. He will share more information when it becomes available.

Mr. Herriman stated that he attended the Nation to Nation Meeting in Quapaw, Oklahoma with Director Lam. He stated that he thought it was an excellent opportunity for members of the conservation sector to network and become more acquainted. He noted that there were twelve tribes in attendance.

Mr. Forst stated that he had nothing to report on this month.

Mr. Clark stated he attended the Grazing for Profits seminar in Ada, Oklahoma. He noted that there were ninety attendees.

OKLAHOMA CONSERVATION COMMISSION STAFF

Executive Director: Mr. Lam stated a written report is in the packet. Mr. Lam reported on the following items:

- Attend the OACD South Central Meeting.
- Attended a National Water Conference listening session.
- Attended the Little River Conservation District board meeting in Idabel, Oklahoma.
- Attended the Nation to Nation Meeting in Quapaw, Oklahoma.

- Attended the Grazing for Profits seminar in Ada, Oklahoma.

Water Quality Program: Shanon Phillips, Director stated a written report was in the packet. Mrs. Phillips reported on the following items:

- Outreach efforts have been directed towards tribes. She also stated that she would like to thank NRCS for partnering with them in these efforts.
- Blue Thumb and Soil Health are working together to mimic the water quality monitoring program with a soil quality monitoring program.
- Two EPA grants for wetlands have been approved.

Office of Geographic Information and Technical Services: Shellie Willoughby, GIS Specialist, stated a written report is in the packet. She noted that OKMaps is operational and running smoothly. She stated that data is available at this time.

Abandoned Mine Land Reclamation Program: Trampas Tripp, Abandoned Mine Lands Program Assistant, stated that a written report was in the Commissioner's packet.

- AML remediated 2 emergencies in August, bringing the total emergencies to 5 for 2019;
- The AML Division has 1 project under construction in Rogers County;
- AML is performing vegetative management and maintenance monitoring on 5 projects;
- They have completed American Burying Beetle surveys on 4 projects and had clear surveys on 3 sites that we will begin to move to contracting. We had ABB presence on the joint partnership project with the Cherokee Nation in Muskogee County. That project will be postponed for the second time until August 2020, pending another ABB survey;
- AML has 7 projects in the design stage;
- AML currently has one project in planning;
- Two AML staff members attend OSMRE courses for professional development. One course was on NEPA: National Environmental Policy Act and the other course was on Historical and Archeological Resources.

Conservation Programs: Tammy Sawatzky, Director stated that a written report was in the packet. Mrs. Sawatzky reported on the following items:

- As the contractor were bore drilling through the dam on Cottonwood 54, they struck rock. The contractor was shut down on the site on August 27, 2019 in order to come up with an alternative strategy. NRCS then performed an ultrasound to determine where the rock is located within the site. The contractor believes that they can continue with the approved upon plan. They will be submitting another plan for approval to accommodate the changes.
- The Soil Health Initiative was just launched. Mrs. Sawatzky did three conference call training sessions with conservation district employees. She stated that the Soil Health Initiative received a "cool reception".
- Held an all-day training session for watershed technicians and watershed aides at the Oklahoma Conservation Commission headquarters in Oklahoma City.

Assistant Director: Mrs. Owen noted that monthly activities are outlined in the written report. Mrs. Owen reported on the following items:

- Submitted two feral swine proposals for pilot programs. In October, 2019, we should know if we will be participating in the eradication program.
- Attend a retirement reception for Frank Acker of the Little River Conservation District. He was an employee of the district for twenty-seven years.
- Both Long Range Plans and Joint Plans of Operation are nearly completed.

AML Project Management

Wagner Emergency (Latimer County)

The project was declared an emergency by the Conservation Commission on July 26, 2019. This project addressed the sudden collapse of an abandoned underground coal mine creating a dangerous vertical opening. Project was completed on August 16, 2019, at a cost of \$11,617.

Ashley Emergency (LeFlore County)

Project was completed on August 9, 2019, at a cost of \$12,241.

Moore North (Rogers County)

Construction was completed on July 30, 2019, at a cost of \$791,079. A total of 102 acres were reclaimed. Hazards eliminated included 4,800 linear feet of dangerous highwall and 3 hazardous water bodies. Vegetation is in progress.

Moore South (Rogers County)

Construction contract was awarded to Stewart Excavation, LLC, for \$1,020,855. The Notice to Proceed date is January 8, 2019. The contract time is 504 calendar days with a completion date of May 25, 2020. Construction has been delayed by rain.

McMillin-Graf (LeFlore County)

Construction was completed on July 31, 2019, at a cost of \$188,502.90. A total of 17 acres were reclaimed. Hazards eliminated included 1,260 linear feet of dangerous highwall and 3 hazards water bodies.

Pryor South (Muskogee County)

Reclamation construction completed. Vegetation completed. Vegetation and project site are being monitored for maintenance. Site will be fertilized and release letter will be sent to landowner.
