MINUTES

CALL TO ORDER

The Oklahoma Conservation Commission met Monday, August 6, 2018, at the Agriculture Building Conference Room located at 2800 N. Lincoln in Oklahoma City, Oklahoma. The meeting was called to order at 9:30 a.m. by Chair Bill Clark. He stated this was a regular scheduled meeting held in accordance with the Open Meeting Law, Title 25, Oklahoma Statutes, Sections 301 and following as amended. The agenda for this meeting was posted at 1:00 p.m. Thursday, August 2, 2018, at the front entrance of the building.

MINUTES OF PREVIOUS REGULAR MEETING

A motion was made by Mr. Jett and seconded by Ms. LeGrand to approve the minutes of the July 9, 2018 Commission meeting as written. Those voting aye were: Jett, Clark, Campbell, Herriman and LeGrand. Nay votes: none. Motion carried.

CLAIMS/FINANCIAL STATEMENT

Nancy Tackett, Oklahoma Department of Agriculture Comptroller, presented the claims, purchase card summary and financial statement as listed in Exhibit #1. NEW BUSINESS

None.

CONSERVATION PARTNERSHIP REPORTS

Oklahoma Department of Agriculture, Food and Forestry: Betty Thompson, Department of Agriculture Deputy Commissioner, reported on the following items:

- -Participated in a well-attended poultry expansion meeting at the end of July in northeastern Oklahoma. Representative Josh West is asking for setbacks on poultry operations similar to confined animal feeding operations.
 - The Department has received no additional applications for hemp.
- The Department has a goal of recognizing a significant woman in agriculture from each of the 77 counties. They are currently 15 shy of their goal.

Natural Resources Conservation Service: Gary O'Neill, State Conservationist, reported on the following items:

- The Agency has requested additional funding to assist landowners with wildfire recovery.
- All acres have been allocated into the Conservation Stewardship Program and staff is currently working on contracts.
 - There are two new easements to enroll into the easement programs.
- The announcement for the district conservationist positions has closed and interviews will be conducted the last two weeks of August. The interview panel will include the State Conservationist from Colorado.
- Have also advertised for three soil conservationists, two GS11 soil conservationists for Lawton and Mangum, an engineer for Pauls Valley, programs assistant in Kingfisher and a tools specialist for the state office.
- Twenty-three student interns gave presentations to leadership staff following their summer internship. Announcement of next year's intern program will come out November or December.
- Attended the National Engineers meeting in Norman and hosted the group on a tour of the ARS facility. There was a breakout session to discuss potential changes to the watershed handbook dealing with land right. National headquarters has announced the availability of \$100,000,000 for new watershed projects and / or funding for backlog of projects.
- -NRCS has entered into an agreement with the Commission to hire two nutrient planners to work in the northeaster and southeastern part of Oklahoma.

Oklahoma Association of Conservation Districts: Jimmy Emmons, President, reported on the following items:

- The Association is hosting four field days in August as part of the RCPP project in Craig County, Dewey County, Kiowa County and Shawnee Conservation Districts.
 - There are currently 14 Farm to Food Bank garden sites in production.
- The Association is making plans to participate in the NACD South Central meeting in San Marcos in September.
- The second session of the Leadership Class was held at the Noble Research Institute focusing on soil health; the third session will be held in Tahlequah in September and focus on water quality.

OKLAHOMA CONSERVATION COMMISSION MEMBERS

Mr. Campbell reported that he attended the OACD Leadership session at Noble Research Institute.

Mr. Jett reported that he attended a meeting with the project manager for Western Farmers to discuss the substation upgrade project in Kingfisher County.

Mr. Herriman reported that he attended a meeting with the Regional Administrator from EPA in Wagoner. He indicated it was an excellent opportunity for OCC to show the good work

being done in Oklahoma.

Ms. LeGrand reported that her local conservation district along with Custer County had agreed to host the OACD Area 4 meeting on November 6 at the Frisco Center in Clinton.

Mr. Clark stated he had nothing to report this month.

OKLAHOMA CONSERVATION COMMISSION STAFF

Executive Director: Mr. Lam stated a written report is in the packet. Mr. Lam reported on the following items:

- Met with the Oklahoma Capitol Improvement Authority to discuss bond for the watershed rehabilitation program. The Authority has developed a team this month that will work through the bonding process.
- Participated in the second session of the OACD Leadership Class at Noble Research Institute. He noted that the class is really coming together as a unit and building comradery. Made arrangements for long time serving Chair of the Arbuckle Conservation District board, Creede Speake to address the group about the watershed program.
- Conducted a field tour of Fourteen Mile Creek in Wagoner County with EPA Region 6 Administrator, Anne Idsal, Secretary of Agriculture, Jim Reese, and OCC Commissioner Scotty Herriman and OCC staff. The group discussed what agriculture is doing to help keep streams clean and to show that monitoring and voluntary programs are successful.

Water Quality Program: Shanon Phillips, Director stated a written report was in the packet. Ms. Phillips reported on the following items:

- The Division was narrowing down success stories to twelve; each of which is showing the value of voluntary programs.
- Lake Eufaula wetland project is being finished up that was funded through the Oklahoma Water Resources Board Clean Water State Revolving Fund.
- Former employee Cheryl Cheadle will be coming out of retirement to become the Blue Thumb Volunteer Coordinator.

Office of Geographic Information and Technical Services: Mike Sharp, Director, stated a written report is in the packet. He noted that this was a fairly routine month for the division.

Abandoned Mine Land Reclamation Program: Robert Toole, Director, stated that a written report was in the Commissioner's packet. Mr. Toole summarized the report stating that: construction is on-going on one (1) project; five (5) projects are pending environmental clearances for an authorization to proceed; monitoring and vegetation management is being performed on four (4) projects; three (3) projects are in the design phase; realty was cleared on two (2) sites that were being prepared for the use of police powers to perform reclamation; seven (7) sites are pending project selection.

Toole reported that resources have been directed to Coal County to identify and assess AML sites for inclusion on the AML inventory. Toole concluded by noting that the Office of Surface Mining Reclamation and Enforcement (OSMRE) had approved the cooperative agreement grant in the amount of \$99,700.00 to perform maintenance on a Cherokee Nation AML reclamation site in conjunction with a state AML reclamation project. The project will be a cooperative effort involving the Cherokee Nation, Muskogee County Conservation District, OSMRE and Oklahoma

AML Program.

Conservation Programs: Tammy Sawatzky, Director stated that a written report was in the packet. Ms. Sawatazky reported on the following items:

- The watershed technicians made a presentation with their equipment at the ARS lab during the National Engineers Conference.
- Cost Share Program Year 18 is slated to end on August 31. All payments must be in the Commission by this date.

Assistant Director: Ms. Owen noted that monthly activities are outlined in the written report. Ms. Owen reported on the following items:

- Met with the State Auditor to discuss options for conservation district auditing requirements.
- Participated in a meeting with NRCS and Commission staff to discuss conservation planning staffing agreements.
- Assisted Logan, Bryan, Garfield and Osage County Conservation Districts due to vacancies occurring at the end of the quarter. Finalized hiring staff in Logan County and assisted with board meeting preparation. Completed quarterly taxes for these four districts.
 - Participated in the Oklahoma Prescribe Burn Association board meeting.

OCTOBER COMMISSION MEETING

The board discussed the date of the October Commission meeting noting a conflict between the meeting and staff attendance to the NASCA meeting. After discussion, Mr. Herriman made a motion, seconded by Ms. LeGrand, to move the October Commission Meeting to October 8, 2018 in the Agriculture Building Board Room, 2800 N. Lincoln Boulevard, Oklahoma City, Oklahoma beginning at 9:30 a.m.
