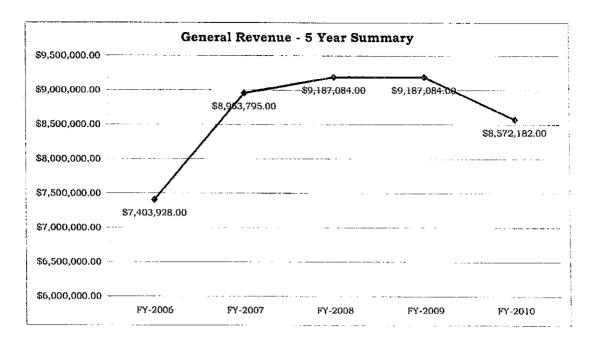

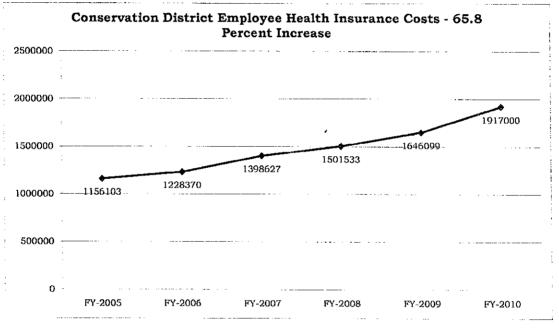

AML EMERGENCY PROGRAM

410 Choctaw (Pittsburg County)

The site was declared an emergency by the Oklahoma Conservation Commission on July 23, 2009. This project addresses an emergency situation involving the sudden collapse of an abandoned underground coal mine creating a sinkhole in the ditch of Choctaw Avenue in Harshorne, Oklahoma. The dangerous vertical sinkhole is 3.8 feet in diameter by 8.5 feet deep, and is 104 feet from the nearest residence. It has active erosion taking dirt deeper underground, indicating a strong probability of a void underneath. The sinkhole has open access to the street.

Contract was awarded to Marks Construction, LLC. Project was completed on August 3 for \$11,076.

402 E. Highway 270 (Pittsburg County)

The site was declared an emergency by the Oklahoma Conservation Commission on July 29, 2009. This project addresses an emergency situation involving the sudden collapse of an abandoned underground coal mine creating a subsidence in Highway 270 in Alderson, Oklahoma. The dangerous subsidence area starts near 402 E. Highway 270 and goes east on Highway 270 for approximately 500 feet.

The Conservation Commission is working on an agreement with the Oklahoma Department of Transportation to do core drilling to located the extent of the mine void.
