MINUTES

CALL TO ORDER

The Oklahoma Conservation Commission met Monday, November 2, 2020, in the Agriculture Building Conference Room located at 2800 N. Lincoln Boulevard in Oklahoma City, Oklahoma and via open teleconference. The meeting was called to order at 9:30 a.m. by Chair Phil Campbell. He stated this was a regular scheduled meeting held in accordance with the Open Meeting Law, Title 25, Oklahoma Statutes, Sections 301 and will include teleconferencing in compliance with the Open Meetings Act as amended by Senate Bill 661. The agenda for this meeting was posted at 1:00 p.m. Thursday, October 29, 2020, at the front entrance of the Oklahoma Agriculture Building, 2800 N. Lincoln Boulevard, Oklahoma City, Oklahoma, as well as on the agency's website www.ok.gov/conservation.

MINUTES OF PREVIOUS REGULAR MEETING

A motion was made by Scotty Herriman and seconded by Karl Jett to approve the minutes of the October 5, 2020 Commission meeting as written. A roll call vote was taken and those voting aye were: Forst, Herriman, Jett, Campbell and Crawley. Nay votes: none. Motion carried.

CLAIMS/FINANCIAL STATEMENT

Commissioners reviewed the claims register, p-card statement, revenue summary and allotment budget / available cash report as provided by Oklahoma Department of Agriculture Comptroller Bob Richardson in Exhibit #1. Ms. Owen stated claims have been processed through October 22, 2020, in the amount of \$2,599,451.70. She briefly covered all claims and reports status for approval. A motion was made by Mr. Crawley and seconded by Mr. Forst to approve the financial reports as presented. A roll call vote was taken and those voting aye were: Forst, Herriman, Jett, Campbell and Crawley. Nay votes: none. Motion carried.

PRESENTATION OF AGREEMENTS

Mr. Lam presented one new agreement for approval listed on Exhibit #2 as items “a”. He recommended approval of this new agreement. A motion was made by Mr. Jett and seconded by Mr. Herriman to approve the new agreement as presented. A roll call vote was taken and those voting aye were: Forst, Herriman, Jett, Crawley and Campbell. Nay votes: none. Motion carried.

CONSERVATION DISTRICT DIRECTOR APPOINTMENT

Ms. Owen presented the appointment of James New, Jr. as a new director to the Delaware County Conservation District. He will be filling the position vacated by Dusti Graves. A motion was made by Mr. Herriman and seconded by Mr. Forst to approve the appointment as presented. A roll call vote was taken and those voting aye were: Forst, Herriman, Jett, Crawley and Campbell. Nay votes: none. Motion carried.

2021 CONSERVATION COMMISSION MEETING DATES

Ms. Owen presented suggested dates for calendar year 2021 Commission meetings as outlined in Exhibit #3. All dates are for the first Monday of the month except for July and September due to state holidays. A motion was made by Mr. Forst and seconded by Mr. Crawley to approve the new calendar year 2021 meeting dates as presented. A roll call vote was taken and those voting aye were: Forst, Herriman, Jett, Crawley and Campbell. Nay votes: none. Motion carried.

CO-SPONSORSHIP OF THE OKLAHOMA ASSOCIATION OF CONSERVATION DISTRICTS’ ANNUAL STATE MEETING

Mr. Lam stated that the OACD annual meeting is still scheduled for February 28 – March 2, 2021. To date, there has not been a decision made whether to hold the meeting virtually or in person. Mr. Lam indicated that each year, the agency co-sponsors the annual meeting; and would like to again this year in whatever form the meeting takes. This would include registration for staff, and staff support for planning and executing the meeting. A motion was made by Mr. Jett and seconded by Mr. Forst to approve the co-sponsorship of the annual meeting. A roll call vote was taken and those voting aye were: Forst, Herriman, Jett, Crawley and Campbell. Nay votes: none.

CONSERVATION PARTNERSHIP REPORTS

Oklahoma Department of Agriculture, Food and Forestry: JanLee Rowlett, Oklahoma Department of Agriculture Legislative Liaison reported on the following items:

- Building is closed and they are assessing things on a weekly basis. There is not a date set yet to re-open. Keeping everyone informed of updates.

- EPA informed of new guidance on Dicamba registration and new products. There have been concerns from producers across the state with the June 30th deadline and how it might not work as well in OK as other states. Dept. of Ag is working as a liaison between the producers and the EPA to find flexibility. Still working out details and hope to share more information soon.

- Continuing on preparation for the upcoming legislative session. The Dept is looking to add additional meat inspector positions. This could be a challenge due to budget but will be making a request to increase capacity in the state of OK. Other policy requests are being looked at as well.

USDA-Natural Resources Conservation Service: Gary O'Neill, State Conservationist, reported on the following items:

- Starting FY 2021 and the agency is working to get CSP payments completed. There is a deadline on November 6, 2020, to get payments made. To date about 5,200 payments have been completed.

- The State Technical Committee Meeting will meet on MS Teams this coming Thursday. Rollout of programs in FY21 will be discussed along with final rules for EQIP and CSP. The Agency expects final rule on easement programs soon.

- Covid-19 update: Not much change in offices re-opening and continue to monitor closely. Continue to encourage employees to follow guidelines for safety.

- Received positive news for hiring - the agency was given direct hire authority for 1,500 positions across the country. There is a data call this week to see how many positions will be requested in OK. These will all be entry-level positions.

- The second round of feral swine pilot project proposals are due this week. The agency expanded the two initial areas that were funded on the first round of proposals.

- Jeannie Hamilton will be serving as Oklahoma's Acting Assistant for Management and Strategy for 60-90 days. She currently is an Assistant for Field Operations in South Dakota and due to the high COVID numbers she is working remotely. If COVID numbers decrease she may be able to come to Oklahoma soon. She is in a leadership development program, and this will give her an opportunity to stretch in some of her responsibilities in strategy management.

- Looking at the Emergency Watershed Program (EWP) for funding opportunities due to the ice storm last week. EWP can provide funds for cleaning up debris out of channels, streams and creeks. A Request has been sent to headquarters.

Oklahoma Association of Conservation Districts: Larry Wright, OACD President gave the

following updates:

- The NACD South Central Regional quarterly meeting scheduled for this week will have to be rescheduled due to weather and other unforeseen issues that came up.
- The NACD annual meeting that was scheduled for February 2021 in New Orleans, Louisiana has been transitioned to a virtual conference. More information will be coming out in the coming month.
- Urban and Committee Ag Resource Policy Group for NACD continues to work on grants for 2021. The policy group is also hosting a webinar later this month that will feature Oklahoma's Yard by Yard Project in Oklahoma and Tulsa Counties.
- The Care Project is getting underway. There will be more information available soon.

OKLAHOMA CONSERVATION COMMISSION MEMBERS

Mr. Jett – stated that he had good moisture in the panhandle.

Mr. Herriman – no report

Mr. Crawley – stated they had about 3” of rain and a good freeze.

Mr. Campbell – noted that he had been picking up limbs and debris from ice damage.

Mr. Forst – stated that he had been guiding deer hunts for the last 10 days.

OKLAHOMA CONSERVATION COMMISSION STAFF

Executive Director: Mr. Lam reported the following items:

- Several employees are without electricity due to the ice storm, making working remotely a challenge.
- NASCA Virtual Annual Meeting – We had several staff members make presentations. Encouraged others to attend due to the learning possibilities.
- Participated in numerous tribal conference calls working with NRCS, OTCAC, BIA and NACD's Resource Policy Group.
- Feral Swine - Met with District Directors, Legislators and Oklahoma Department of Wildlife Conservation (ODWC) to discuss issues landowners are having in McIntosh County with feral swine. Also, participated in the Pushmataha Conservation District board meeting to discuss the use of the electronic trap purchased through the State Cost Share Program.
- The Commission was notified that the State Auditor's Office will be conducting a financial audit of the agency. Ed Crall will take the lead for the Commission. Several staff are gathering requested documentation.
- Discussing options on where to hold the December Commission meeting. Special provisions in the Open Meeting Act expire after November 15 that allowed Board and Commissions to meet via video conference and teleconference.

Water Quality Program: Shanon Phillips reported that there was a report provided in the packet. Due to the ice storm and power outages last week they were unable to have their Non-Point Source Review with the EPA. The Division is looking to reschedule within the next few weeks. The EPA Model Training on the Illinois River Model was also cancelled, and a new date has not been set. Division staff have had multiple conversations with different industries and groups about carbon sequestration. There are several groups interested in carbon sequestration from the standpoint of

showing that their industry is carbon neutral, instead of just selling carbon credits. Discussing the potential to develop a pilot program to look at what carbon sequestration could look like for particular industries. The soil health team has conducted multiple field visits and consultations this month. Water Quality staff has also held some groundwater screenings and are appreciative of the partnership with the Conservation Districts.

Office of Geographic Information and Technical Services: Mike Sharp, Director, stated a written report is in the packet. He noted that the Next Generation 911 projects are underway. Contract was awarded to Datamark who will be developing three training classes to bring people up to speed on GIS and get people familiar with the new state standard for 911 data. Those trained will become familiar with the state repository on how to upload data and processing. Another grant OGITS is working on is for the state repository, with the contract being awarded to Coordinate Solutions, which is the developer on OK Maps. With the grant funds, the Division is looking to make upgrades to OK Maps equipment and begin moving data storage into new storage facilities.

Abandoned Mine Land Reclamation Program: Robert Toole, Abandoned Mine Lands (AML) Reclamation Program Director, stated that a written report was in the Commissioners' packets and he would answer questions on any information in the report. Mr. Toole stated they completed one project in Roger's County this last month, that being Moore South, and got it vegetated in time to get moisture. There is one project under construction in Haskell County. AML is moving two projects through contracting at this time, one in Roger's County and another in Muskogee County. They have 6 projects in the vegetation management and maintenance monitoring stage, 3 projects in design, working really on 3 projects, mailed a release letter on one project, pursuing environmental clearances on 2 projects and requested authorization to proceed from the Office of Surface Mining Reclamation and Enforcement on 2 projects and are hoping for those authorizations this week. The American Bearing Beetle has been delisted from the Endangered Species Act, which is helpful and gives additional 4 more months to clear trees before the next environmental restriction limits construction. Lastly, reauthorization is currently at a standstill, and probably will not go anywhere until after the election.

Conservation Programs: Tammy Sawatzky, Director reported on the following items:

- Completed EWP Repairs on Uncle John's Site.
- Completed remedial repairs on drop structures on Devil's Canyon and Ferrell Rock Drop in the South Caddo District. Also, completed remedial repairs on Caney Coon 2 and North Deer Creek.
- Have accepted bids on the Caddo Sites in the Arbuckle Conservation District. Damage was caused by the landowner placing concrete in the towers; contractor is in place to begin repairs.
- Have a remedial repair job in Wagoner County. on the Kadashan Bottom Channel 1.
- Accepted a bid for the decommissioning of the Bear Creek Site 3 in Custer County.
- Rehab project on Cottonwood Site 54 – Started on Phase 2, but has already been delayed by rain. The goal is to have the site completed by July 1.
- Cost Share Program Year 20 came was completed at the end of September. Currently working on the final report and should be ready for the December Meeting.
- The Commission extended an offer to Taylor Marshall to become the new Cost-Share Coordinator. She accepted and will be starting work on December 1.

Assistant Director: Lisa Knauf Owen reported on the following items:

- Option period for benefits enrollment ended on Friday.

- Feral Swine Pilot Projects – Working with staff to get the 2 projects moving forward.

Held a successful strategy meeting this month and will focus on getting staff trained to conduct landowner damage assessments. Another meeting is scheduled for this afternoon to meet with key partners including APHIS and NRCS to talk about moving forward. Will be submitting two more proposals before Thursday as we are trying to expand into two additional counties in northern Oklahoma as well as two additional counties in western Oklahoma along the Texas border.

Mr. Campbell welcomed Tarron Powell to the Conservation Commission.

The next regular meeting of the Oklahoma Conservation Commission will be held on Monday, December 7, 2020, in the Oklahoma Department of Agriculture Board Room. 2800 N. Lincoln Blvd., Oklahoma City, Oklahoma at 9:30 a.m.

COMMUNICATIONS OVERVIEW

The use of videos on the OCC YouTube Channel appears to be going very well.

Communications Director Bryan Painter has written a release about this video project that will be sent to newspapers around Thanksgiving and is scheduled for the December issue of Oklahoma Farm & Ranch magazine. Mari'a Simpson is the District Secretary for the Cotton County Conservation District in southern Oklahoma. In mid-October, she said that in recent months, her District had been holding board meetings via teleconference. She refers to the videos as “a blessing.”

Here's a quote from the article: “With the wide variety of training videos available, we chose to start at the beginning and started with the Introduction video; to know exactly what OCC expected of us and what options were available to the district for continued education,” Simpson said. “The videos have been a blessing. Sometimes life on the farm makes it difficult for all five of the directors to take a whole day off to attend Area Meetings. With the videos, all the directors can watch the videos at their convenience and discuss them at the next board meeting. The next video we watched was on Feral Hogs. Cotton County is one of four counties participating in the Red River Pilot Program in southwest Oklahoma. Directors and staff have watched several additional videos from the Commission's YouTube page. The videos are very useful, and information can be used in daily activities.”

Communications has also been assisting in Blue Thumb's calendar project. Producers will be featured in the 2021 calendar. As a supplement to that, Candice Miller shot videos of each producer and Bryan Painter wrote features of each producer. Those features assigned, have been completed, and those producers are: Suzanne Landess, Dean Schneider, Dr. Katie Blunk, Grant Victor, Elia Woods and Pat Hoerth, Katie Williams, Phil Campbell, Kit and Josh Dinwiddie, and Greg Scott.

Discussions have been opened to discuss settlement and moving forward with the project.

- **Criner Creek Site 5** – Discussion with NRCS on the issues and challenges of rehabilitating the site upon the request and possible funding of the landowner.
- Other Flood control Issues:
 - **Caddo Creek Sites & Lower Bayou Creek Site 8** – The Attorney General's Office (AGO) is waiting for repairs to be made to clarify actual costs for collections. Repairs are in progress.
 - **Rock Creek Site 15** – Ongoing discussions with the District regarding access for a landlocked Landowner.
 - **Little Wewoka Creek Site 1** – Coordinating a teleconference with the landowners and the Choctaw Nation to explain the situation and what the District is requesting. Awaiting follow-up from the tribe.
 - **Bear-Fall Coon Creek Site 20** – The property owner placed a home below the lower hazard dam causing the dam to be reclassified as a high hazard dam. The case is in discovery. The NRCS is conducting a hazard classification assessment on the site and will be sharing the results of the assessment with the Logan County District Attorney.
 - **Beaver County Criminal Case CF-2019-23** –The court continued the case from October 13, 2020 to December 8, 2020 for judgment and sentencing to allow the defendant time to raise money toward a lump sum down payment for the amount of restitution to reduce the defendant's monthly installment payments to an amount that she can pay. The District has been asked to provide victim impact statement(s) to the court.
