CALL TO ORDER

The Oklahoma Conservation Commission met Monday, December 2, 2019, in the Agriculture Building Conference Room located at 2800 N. Lincoln in Oklahoma City, Oklahoma. The meeting was called to order at 9:30 a.m. by Chair Karl Jett. He stated this was a regular scheduled meeting held in accordance with the Open Meeting Law, Title 25, Oklahoma Statutes, Sections 301 and following as amended. The agenda for this meeting was posted at 1:00 p.m. Wednesday, November 27, 2019, at the front entrance of the Oklahoma Agriculture Building.

PLEDGE OF ALLEGIANCE

MINUTES OF PREVIOUS REGULAR MEETING

A motion was made by Mr. Clark and seconded by Mr. Campbell to approve the minutes of the November 4, 2019 Commission meeting as written. Those voting aye were: Clark, Herriman, Jett, Forst, and Campbell. Nay votes: none. Motion carried.

CLAIMS/FINANCIAL STATEMENT

Commissioners reviewed the claims, purchase card summary and financial statement as provided by Oklahoma Department of Agriculture Comptroller in Exhibit #1. A motion was made by Mr. Forst and seconded by Mr. Herriman to approve the claims and financial statement. Those voting aye were: Clark, Herriman, Jett, Forst, and Campbell. Nay votes: none. Motion carried.

Mr. Richardson noted that Nancy Tackett, ODAFF Comptroller, will retire at the end of the month. Commissioners thanked Ms. Tackett for her assistance to the agency over the past years.

RECOGNITION OF COMMISSION EMPLOYEE

Scotty Herriman, OCC Area 3 Commissioner, recognized Trey Lam for his five years of service at the Oklahoma Conservation Commission. Mr. Herriman stated that he appreciated the work ethic exhibited by Mr. Lam as well as the intelligent leadership he brings to the agency. Mr. Herriman concluded by stating that the agency is lucky to have Trey serving as its leader.

PRESENTATION OF AGREEMENTS

Staff presented three agreements listed as item "A-C" in Exhibit 2, for possible approval. Mike Sharp, Office of Geographic Information and Technical Services Division Director, presented a new agreement with the Oklahoma Office of Emergency Management — 911 Management Authority to develop a Statewide Next Generation 911 Repository. The Oklahoma State Repository will be the central stand-alone repository that stores the master copy of 9-1-1 GIS data. A motion was made by Mr. Campbell and seconded by Mr. Herriman to approve the OEM agreement as presented. Those voting aye were: Clark, Herriman, Jett, Forst, and Campbell.

Nay votes: none. Motion carried.

Greg Kloxin, Water Quality Division Assistant Director, presented a new agreement with Oklahoma State University to develop a Quality Assurance Project Plan and develop a floodplain mapping protocol. OSU will conduct the majority of the image processing, data analyses, field work and report writing with advisement and assistance from OCC. Mapping will occur in the Arkansas and Canadian River watersheds. A motion was made by Mr. Clark and seconded by Mr. Forst to approve the OSU agreement as presented. Those voting aye were: Clark, Herriman, Jett, Forst, and Campbell. Nay votes: none. Motion carried.

Tammy Sawatzky, Conservation Programs Division Director, presented a new agreement with the Natural Resources Conservation Service to provide technical and financial assistance to OCC, Noble County Conservation District, and East Canadian County Conservation District for Emergency Watershed Protection projects on Upper Black Bear Sites 50, 51, 64, 76, and Uncle John Site 9. A motion was made by Mr. Campbell and seconded by Mr. Forst to approve the NRCS agreement as presented. Those voting aye were: Clark, Herriman, Jett, Forst, and Campbell. Nay votes: none. Motion carried.

RECOMMENDATION FOR APPOINTMENT OF CONSERVATION DISTRICT DIRECTOR

Mr. Lam presented one appointment to the Bryan Conservation District for consideration as outlined in Exhibit #4. A motion was made by Mr. Herriman and seconded by Mr. Campbell to approve the appointment as presented. Those voting aye were: Clark, Herriman, Forst, Jett and Campbell. Nay votes: none. Motion carried.

DECLARATION OF ABANDONED COAL MINE EMERGENCY

Robert Toole, Abandoned Mine Land Division Director, gave background information on the potential AML emergency - Enable 2019-07-07 AML complaint investigation. AML program staff have concluded that the incident is AML related and will recommend that it be declared an emergency. Rain has delayed further on-site investigation needed to collect data to support an emergency declaration. Additionally, more than one landowner is involved and land rights for access to all property involved have been delayed due to stipulations by one landowner that are being negotiated. Consequently, a declaration of emergency has not been approved by the Office of Surface Mining Reclamation and Enforcement (OSMRE) and the Conservation Commission has not formally declared the emergency for ratification today. Mr. Toole recommended tabling the ratification of declaration at this time. A motion was made by Mr. Herriman and seconded by Mr. Forst to table the ratification of the declaration of emergency until the January meeting. Those voting aye were: Clark, Herriman, Jett, Forst and Campbell. Nay votes: none. Motion carried.

CONSERVATION PARTNERSHIP REPORTS

Oklahoma Department of Agriculture, Food and Forestry: Janlee Rowlett, ODAFF Legislative Liaison, reported on the following issues:

- -Forestry Division Staff has been busy managing fires in Western Oklahoma.
- -Staff has been busy helping to organize and prioritize items for the upcoming legislation session.
- -The Department is anxious to being their participation in the Feral Hog Eradication program.

Natural Resources Conservation Service: Gary O'Neill, State Conservationist, reported on the following items:

- -The CSP deadline for payments to be made this year is December 13, 2019.
- -The new CSP Rules have been made available and are open to comments; sign up will begin in 2020.

- -NRCS has hired a new GIS Specialist Five retirements were announced and Rylan West has accepted a new position within the agency.
- -NRCS would like to extend congratulations to the Oklahoma Conservation Commission for being awarded the Feral Hog Eradication grants.
- Oklahoma Association of Conservation Districts: Larry Wright, OACD President gave the following update:
- -Mr. Wright stated that all of the feedback he had received pertaining to the Area Meetings was positive. He noted that the "Lightening Rounds" highlighting district projects and activities was well received.

OKLAHOMA CONSERVATION COMMISSION MEMBERS

- Mr. Jett attended the Area 1 Meeting. He expressed frustration about the low attendance by his area members, particularly by the directors.
- Mr. Campbell stated that he attended the Area 2 Meeting in Oklahoma City as well as the Small Farmers Conference in Oklahoma City.
 - Mr. Herriman stated that he attended the Area 3 Meeting in Okmulgee.
 - Mr. Forst stated that he had nothing to report.
- Mr. Clark attended the Area 5 meeting in McAlester. He noted that the turnout was much better than it had been in the past few years.

OKLAHOMA CONSERVATION COMMISSION STAFF

Executive Director: Mr. Lam stated a written report is in the packet. Mr. Lam reported on the following items:

- He stated that he attended all five Area Meetings. He noted that he really enjoyed the participation in group discussion format.
- Mr. Lam stated that he believed the "Lightening Rounds" were instrumental in getting area meeting attendees to participate and collaborate with each other.
- Mr. Lam stated that he attended the Small Farmers Conference where Commissioner Campbell and NRCS Assistant Chief Kevin Norton spoke.

Water Quality Program: Mr. Kloxin reported on the following items:

- -Water Quality's Blue Thumb Division has been very busy going out to Conservation Districts. Mr. Kloxin stated that a large part of that was due to the solicitation at the Area Meetings.
- -Mrs. Phillips was not in attendance today in order to meet the submission deadline for the RCPP Poultry Proposal.
- -Submission of information for the external audit of the 319 Program is complete. Auditors will provide back information in early 2020.
 - -Riparian Easement payments have been made to the Grand River Dam Authority.

Office of Geographic Information and Technical Services: Mike Sharp, Director, stated a written report is in the packet. He noted that work on the 911 Next Generation project has begun.

Abandoned Mine Land Reclamation Program: Robert Toole, Abandoned Mine Lands Reclamation Program Director, stated that a written report was in the Commissioner's packet. Mr. Toole summarized the report stating that: one (1) emergency has been finalized and one (1) emergency declaration is pending, bringing the total emergencies to seven (7) for 2019; one (1) project is ongoing construction in Rogers County and one (1) project in Rogers County initiated construction; a pre-bid meeting and site showing was completed on one (1) project in Haskell County and the bid opening is scheduled for tomorrow [December 3rd]; one (1) project in Haskell County has been advertised for bids; four (4) projects are being monitored for vegetative management and maintenance; one (1) project is on hold pending ABB survey next year; seven (7) projects are in design; two (2) projects are in realty phase; two (2) projects have had release letters sent to landowners to return operation and maintenance of the project site back to the landowners.

Conservation Programs: Tammy Sawatzky, Director stated that a written report was in the packet. Mrs. Sawatzky reported the following items:

- -Attended the Area Meetings as well and enjoyed the feedback she received at them.
- -Organized training for the new watershed aids.
- -Organized Video Pipe Inspection Camera Training that will be held tomorrow in Chickasha.
- -The Soil Health Initiative Program has gotten off to a slow and challenging start, however there has been one request for additional funds.


