NEW BUSINESS

None.

CONSERVATION PARTNERSHIP REPORTS

Oklahoma Department of Agriculture, Food and Forestry: Jeremy Seiger, Director of the Agriculture and Environmental Management Services Division, state that Mr. Reese and Ms. Thompson were meeting today with a Korean delegation to discuss trade relations.

- Mr. Seiger reported that Mr. Reese had recently met with a Chinese delegation and the Japanese Embassy to discuss trade relations.
- Mr. Seiger reported that the next meeting of the Agriculture Board will be December 13 at Moon Elementary in Oklahoma City. Board members will be serving breakfast to the children along with Ag in the Classroom and there is a planned visit from Santa Claus and his reindeer.
- Mr. Seiger reported that the agency had hired a new Produce Safety Coordinator that began work December 1. One of the main responsibilities of this position is to work with individuals that grow and sell consumable vegetables.
- Mr. Seiger also noted that the Veterinary Feed Directive that requires a prescription for antibiotics in feed has gone into effect.
- USDA-Natural Resources Conservation Service: Gary O'Neill, State Conservationist, reported that the agency has generated \$58 million in Conservation Stewardship (CSP) payments for this year or deferred payment to next year.
- Mr. O'Neill reported that there were 370 renewals for CSP but agency staff is having system issues preventing the renewals to be put in place.
- Mr. O'Neill reported that the agency had announced the application period for Conservation Innovation Grants (CIG). The application period closes January 9 with \$25 million being made available.
 - Mr. O'Neill noted that Regional Conservation Partnership Program (RCPP) applications

should be announced in January or February 2017.

Mr. O'Neill announced that a selection had been made for the Operation and Maintenance Engineer position. This position will work directly with watershed sponsors, conservation districts and Commission on watershed related issues.

Mr. O'Neill also announced that Mark Kelly has been selected for the full-time temporary archeology position. This position is a two year appointment that will provide much needed assistance to K.C. Kraft, NRCS Archeologist.

Oklahoma Association of Conservation Districts: Steve House, President, announced that the state meeting will be held February 26, 27 and 28, 2017 at the Embassy Suites, Oklahoma south of the capitol. He indicated that work is in progress on the agenda for the meeting.

Mr. House recognized Don Armes and indicated that he would be assisting OACD with educating new legislators.

OKLAHOMA CONSERVATION COMMISSION MEMBERS

Mr. Rooker reported that he attended the Keep Oklahoma Beautiful annual banquet.

Mr. Jett reported that he had been assisting Woodward and Ellis County Conservation Districts with a shared service model for a shared equipment manager position. He stated he thought it was working well. Mr. Jett also reported that he had been working with Ellis County to appoint a new director to their vacant position on the board.

Mr. Clark attended the Oklahoma Conservation Task Force meeting at the Noble Foundation. He stated. That this group is working together to get more conservation on the ground.

Ms. LeGrand reported that Area 4 hosted the final area meeting of the year. She commended the Washita County Conservation District on a good meeting.

Mr. Herriman indicated he was looking forward to working with Grant Victor from Ottawa County on future soil health projects.

Mr. Herriman asked for clarification on the Administration's report regarding the airport expansion and its effects on upstream flood control site - Cottonwood Site 33 in East Canadian County Conservation District.

OKLAHOMA CONSERVATION COMMISSION STAFF

Executive Director: Mr. Lam stated a written report is in the packet. He reported that area meetings were wrapped up for another year. He thanked Natural Resources Conservation Service for Robert Hathorne's assistance and the participation of the agency staff.

Mr. Lam noted that he participated in an interview with Oklahoma Department of Agriculture, Food and Forestry on the property recovery from the Lincoln County Conservation District theft.

Mr. Lam reported that the agency is preparing for a move to the second floor of the agriculture building around March 1, 2017. He indicated he had asked Janet Stewart, OCC General Counsel, to coordinate the move.

Mr. Lam reported that he met with members of the Chickasaw Nation to discuss the Arbuckle Watershed project.

Mr. Lam reported that the application period for the Executive Assistant position had closed. He noted that there were more than 40 applications to review with a plan to interview in the coming weeks.

Water Quality Program: Shanon Phillips, Director, stated a written report is in the packet. Ms. Phillips reported that the Blue Thumb staff has been very busy this month and are pleased to announce the selection of Rob Barossi to fill the Blue Thumb Education position beginning January 9, 2017.

Ms. Phillips reported that the Division participated in an Oklahoma Department of Transportation press event announcing the completion of the State Highway 10 stabilization project.

Ms. Phillips reported that the Oklahoma Water Resources Board has asked for assistance in identifying potential projects and partners to submit green infrastructure projects for EPA funding.

Office of Geographic Information and Technical Services: Mike Sharp, Director, stated a written report is in the packet. He also reported that he had opportunity to visit with Jess Lam, IV about drones during the AutoDesk training in Las Vegas.

Abandoned Mine Land Reclamation Program: Robert Toole, AML Director, stated a written report is in the packet. He reported that designs have been completed on two projects.

Conservation Programs: Ms. Owen reported that Tammy Sawatzky, Director, was attending a meeting with the City of Perry regarding rehabilitation of Perry Lake. Ms. Owen stated a written report is in the packet. She reported that the Commission had accepted a bid from C-P Integrated Services for \$1,571,164.37 for Barnitz Creek Dam No. 5 rehabilitation project.

Assistant Director: Ms. Owen noted that monthly activities are outlined in the written report. She also reported that applications are being accepted for the shared NRCS/District position in Muskogee and Wagoner County conservation districts.
